


6) The Church of Philadelphia Rev.3:7-13, Matt.13:45-46 Parable of the Pear of Great Price

7) The Church of Laodicea Rev.3:14-22, Matt.13:47-49 Parable of the drag net This is the water downed institutional church that is alive and well today and will go through the 7 year tribulation period. This is the woman who rides the beast in Rev. 17 and those who are apart of this belief and the end of the age will be cast into the furnace, hell.
