


Melchizedek – is from the line of Ham, a Jebusite –
Gen.10:15-16, from city of Jerusalem (Psalm 76:1-2),

The first Ruler of Jerusalem, a Priest of the most high God
and Godly King, King of peace, King of righteousness.
(Gen.14:1-3).

Melchizedek is the first priest mentioned in scriptures

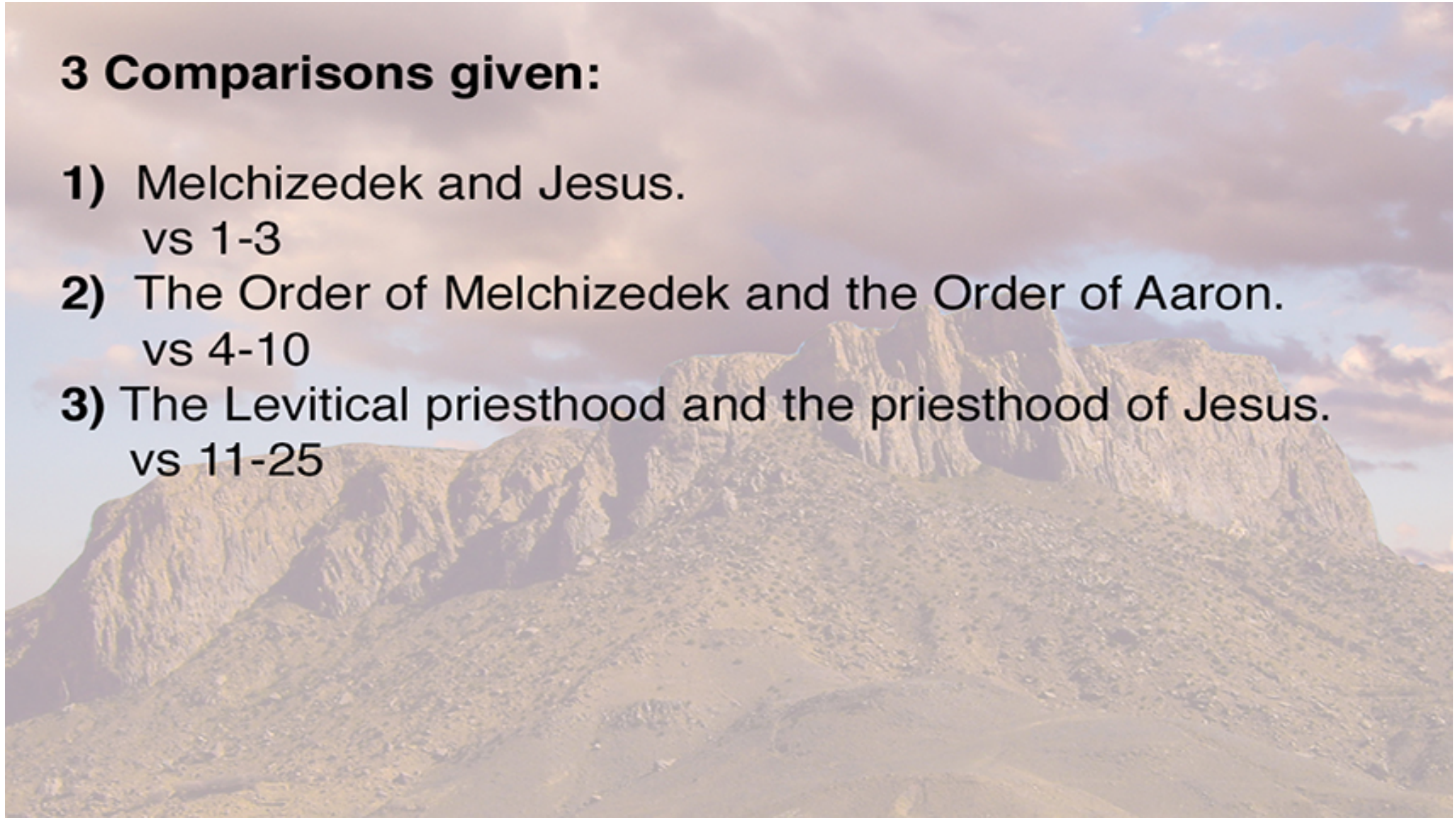
- 
- 1)** Melchizedek was a Priest of the most high God and so is Jesus
 - 2)** Melchizedek was a King of Jerusalem and so is Jesus. In Heb. Jerusalem means is “teaching of peace.”
 - 3)** Melchizedek was the king of righteousness and peace and so is Jesus
 - 4)** Melchizedek was a priest without genealogy pointing back to the tribe of Levi and so is Jesus. Jesus is from the tribe of Judah.
 - 5)** Melchizedek priesthood was timeless, continuous and so is Jesus, he continually ministering.


4 ways Priesthood of Melchizedek is Superior to the Levitical Priesthood

- 1) Superiority is Melchizedek accepted tithes
- 2) Superiority is in the form of blessing
- 3) Superiority is Melchizedek's priesthood never ended.
- 4) Superiority is the respect given by Levi to Melchizedek

Feast of Passover – foreshadows the death of Jesus

Feast of Unleavened bread – Foreshadows the burial of Jesus

Feast of Firstfruits – Foreshadows the resurrection of Jesus

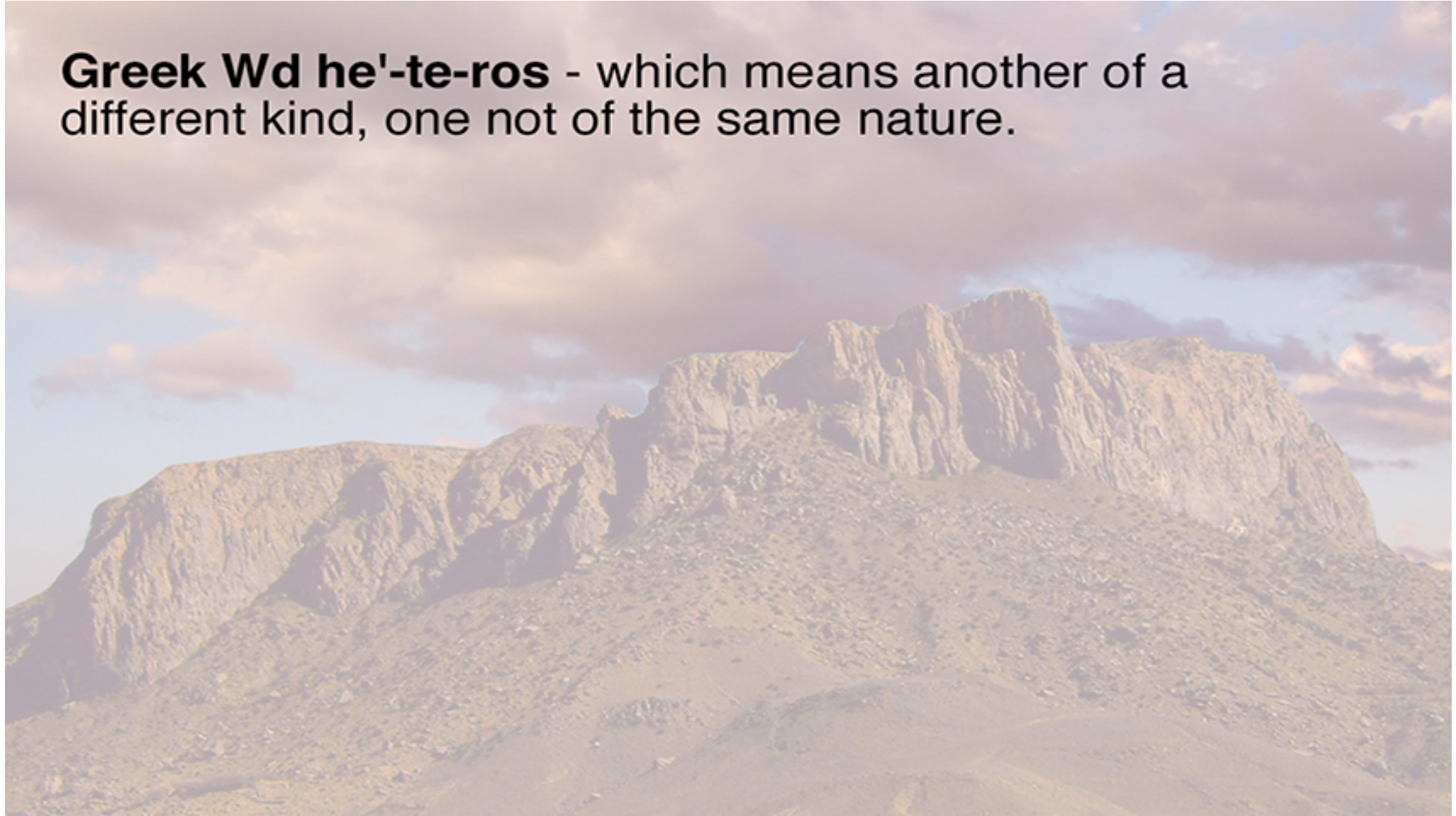
Feast of weeks or Pentecost – Foreshadows the Church or bride of Jesus. This is the time period we are in today. But the next event that will take place is foreshadowed in the Feast of trumpets.

Feast of trumpets – Foreshadows the Rapture

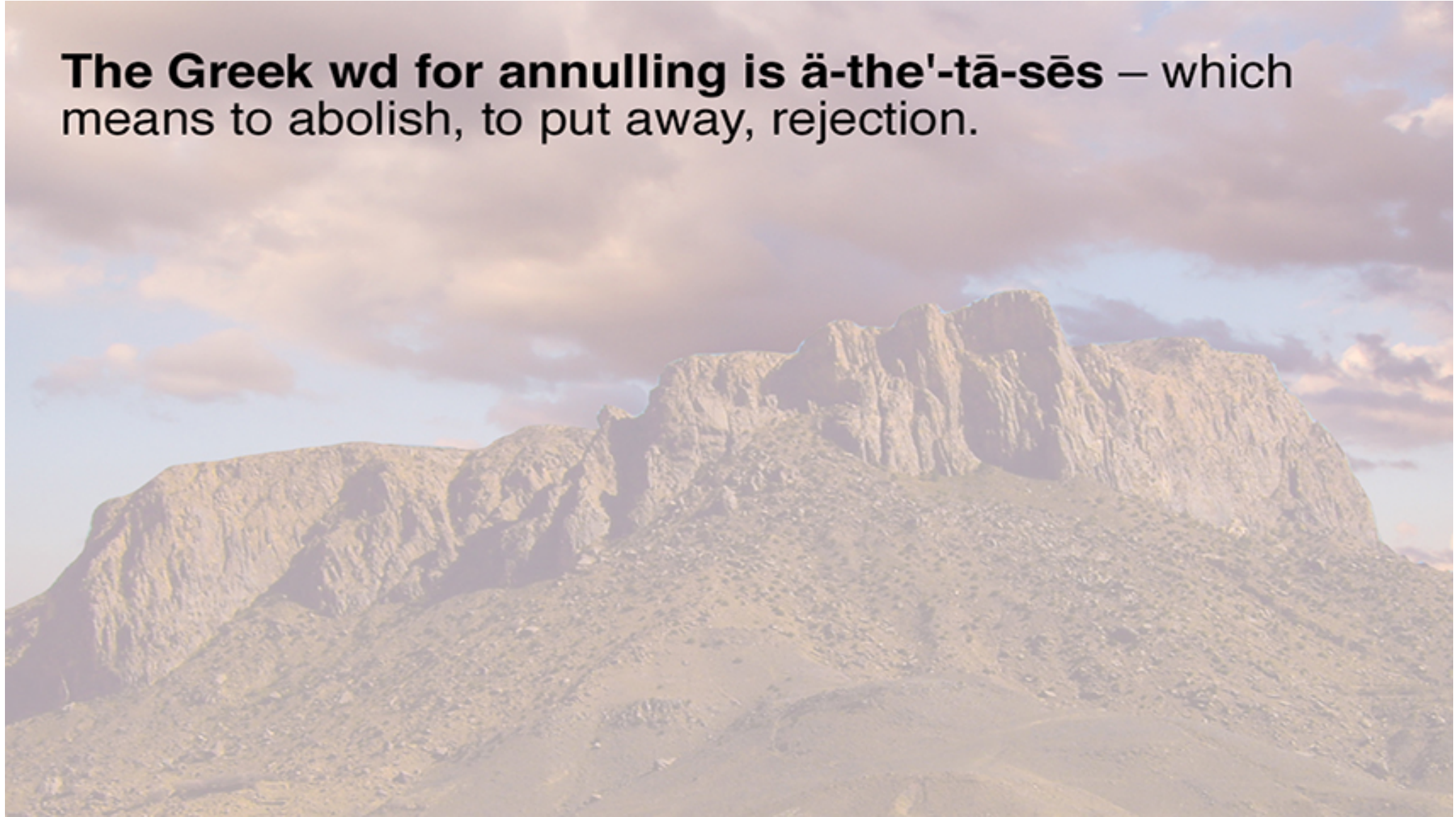
Feast of Day of Atonement – Foreshadows the days of judgment, 7 year Tribulation period

Feast of Tabernacles – Foreshadows the second coming of Jesus which begins the Millennium Kingdom of 1,000 years of Christ reigning on the earth.

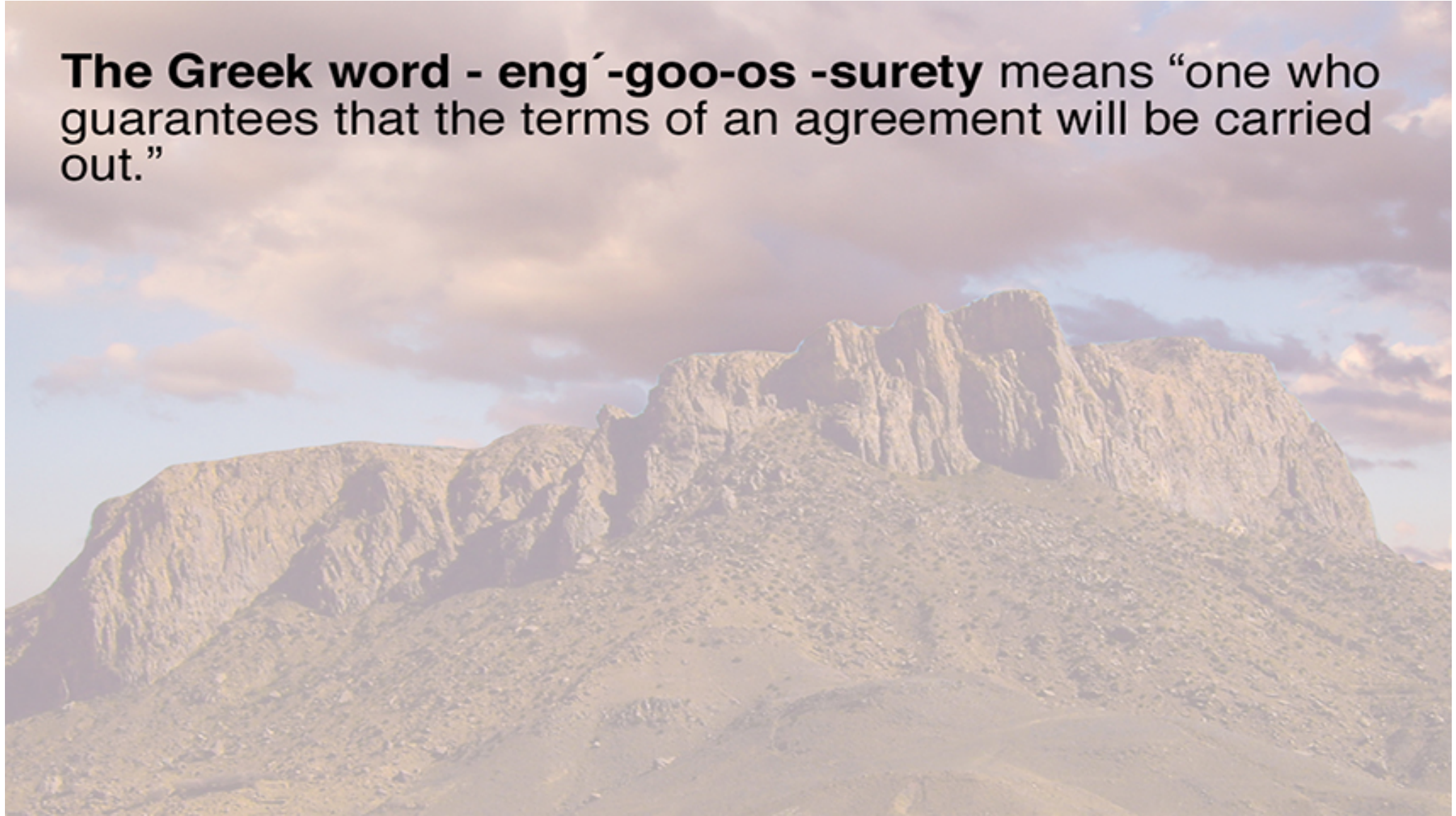
Greek Wd he'-te-ros - which means another of a different kind, one not of the same nature.



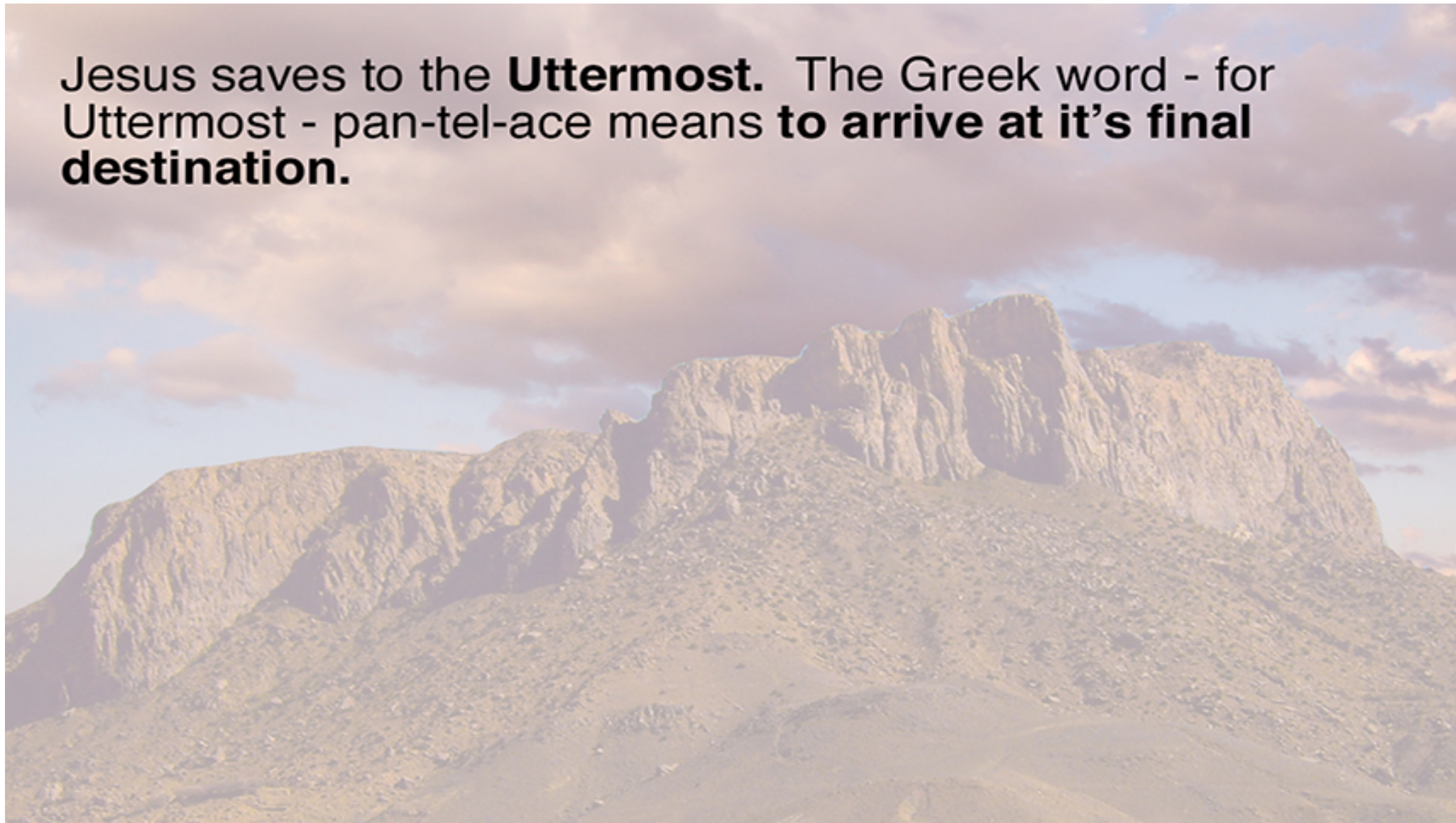
The Greek wd for annulling is ä-the'-tā-sēs – which means to abolish, to put away, rejection.



The Greek word - eng'-goo-os -surety means “one who guarantees that the terms of an agreement will be carried out.”



Jesus saves to the **Uttermost**. The Greek word - for Uttermost - pan-tel-ace means **to arrive at it's final destination.**



3 Parts of Salvation

1) **Past** – we are saved from the penalty of Sin –
Justification – peace with God and free from His wrath.

(Rom.5:1)

2) **Present** – we are saved from the bondage of sin –
Sanctification – this is learning to walk in victory over sin
by submitting to Christ. (Rom.6:12 -8:16)

3) **Future** – we are saved from the very presence of sin
– **Glorification** – when we are in the very presence of
God in a glorified body. (Rom.8:17-26)
