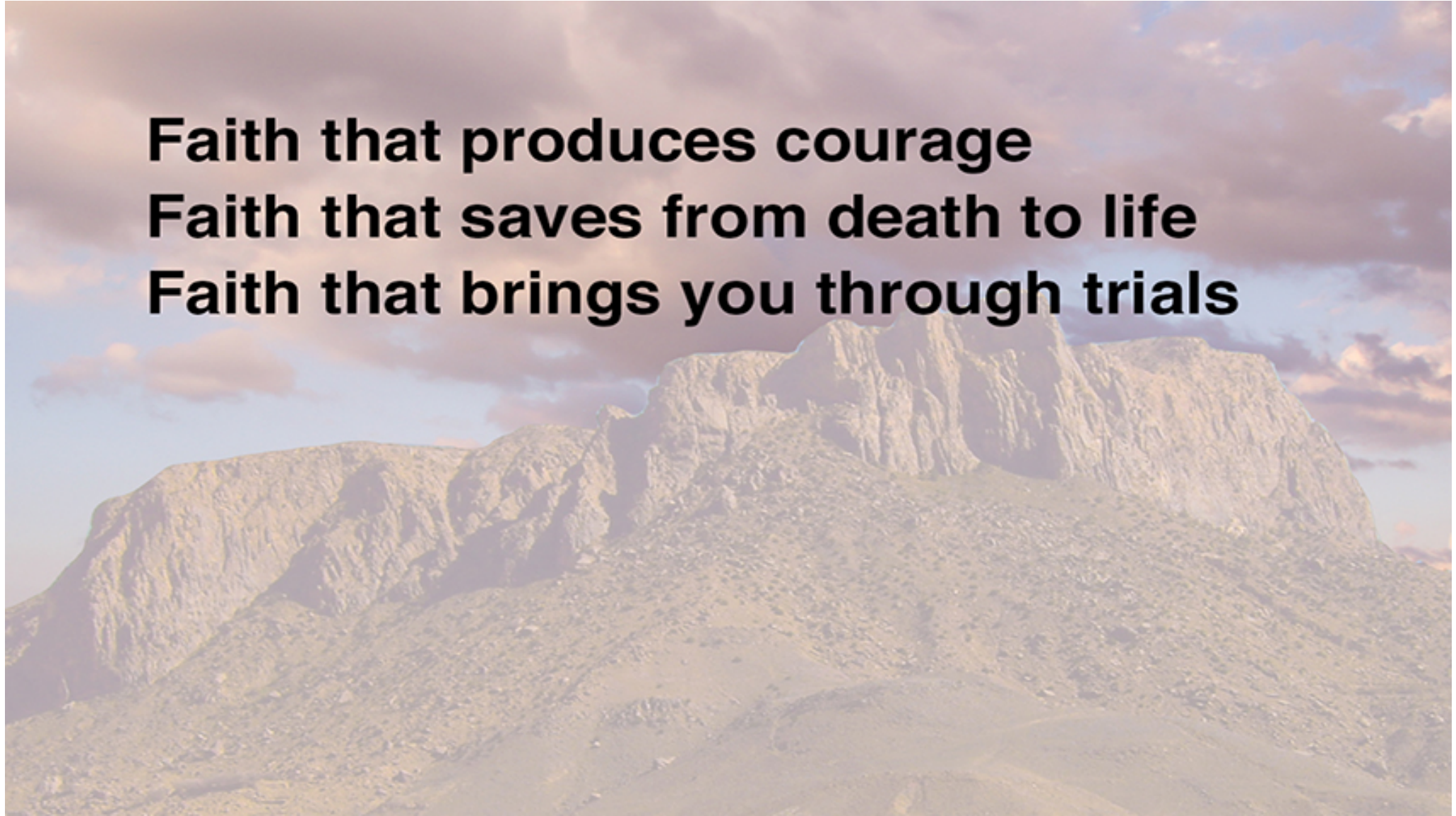

Moses lived 120 years (Duet. 34:7)

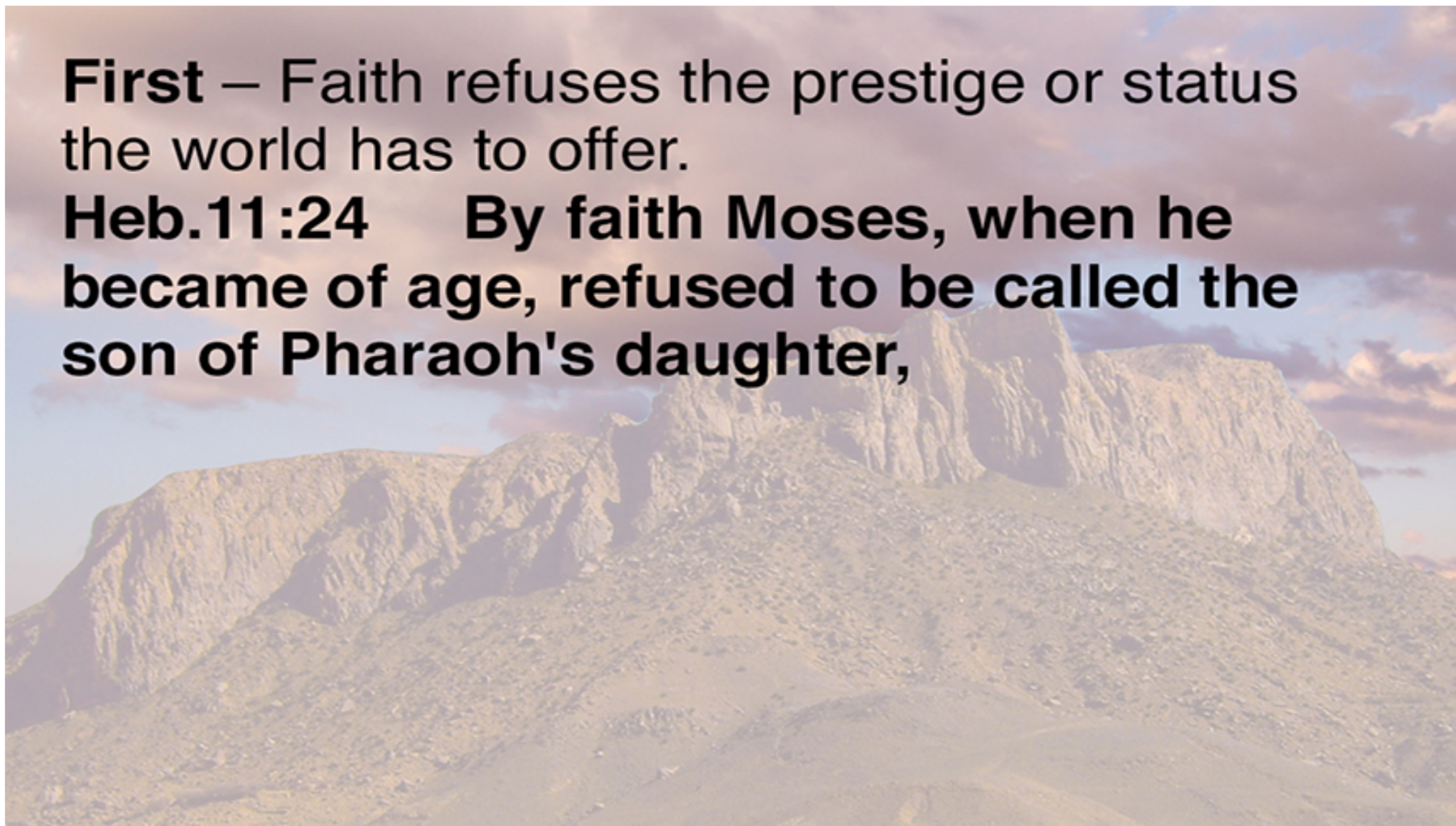
40 years in Pharaoh's household


40 years as a Shepherd in the wilderness

Heb.11:24 By faith Moses, when he became of age, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter,





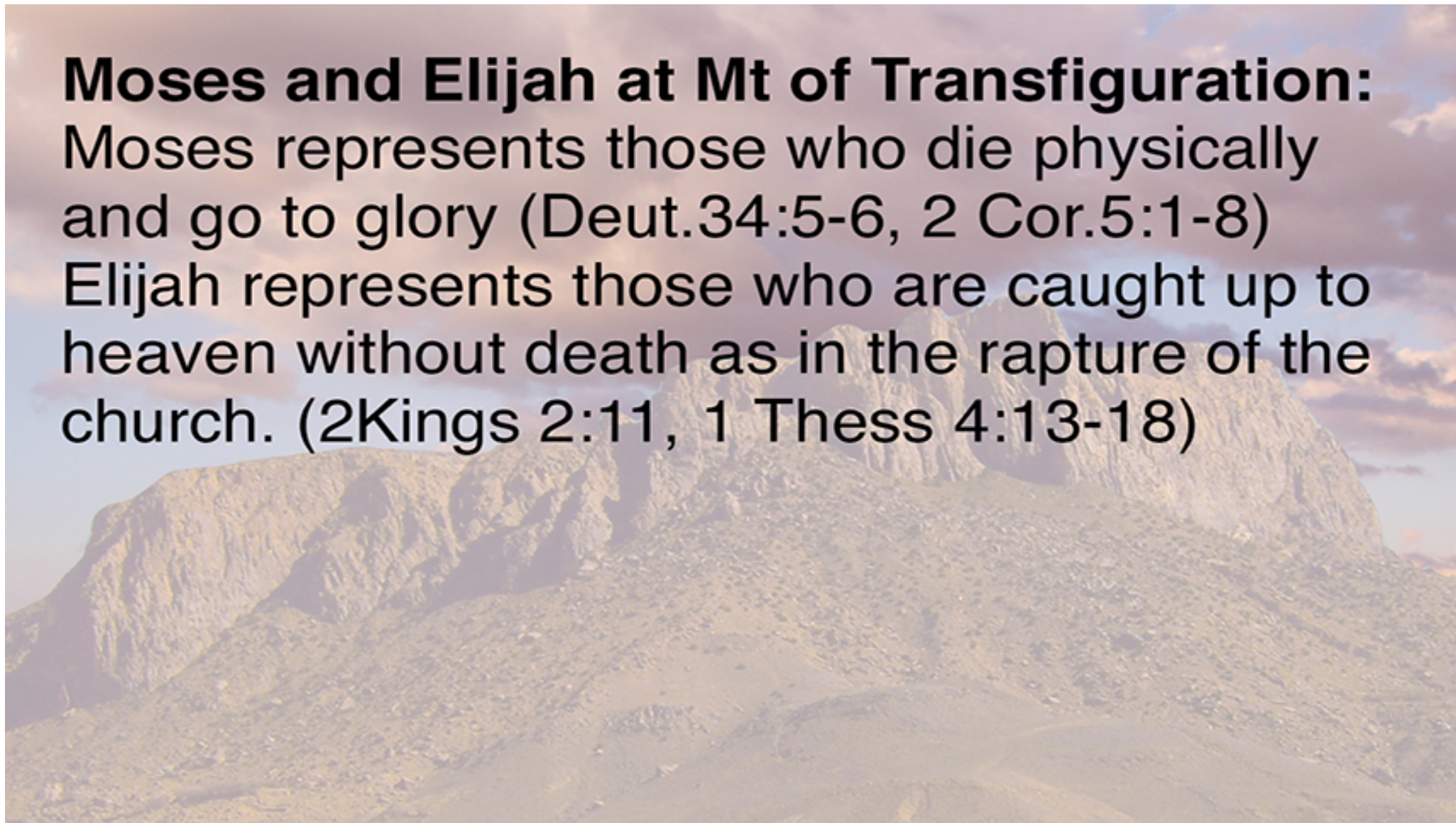
Second - The refusal of pleasure of sin led to the reproach of faith, or being treated poorly because of his faith.

Heb 11:26 - esteeming the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasures in Egypt; for he looked to the reward.

Moses and Elijah at Mt of Transfiguration:

Moses represents those who die physically and go to glory (Deut.34:5-6, 2 Cor.5:1-8)

Elijah represents those who are caught up to heaven without death as in the rapture of the church. (2Kings 2:11, 1 Thess 4:13-18)
