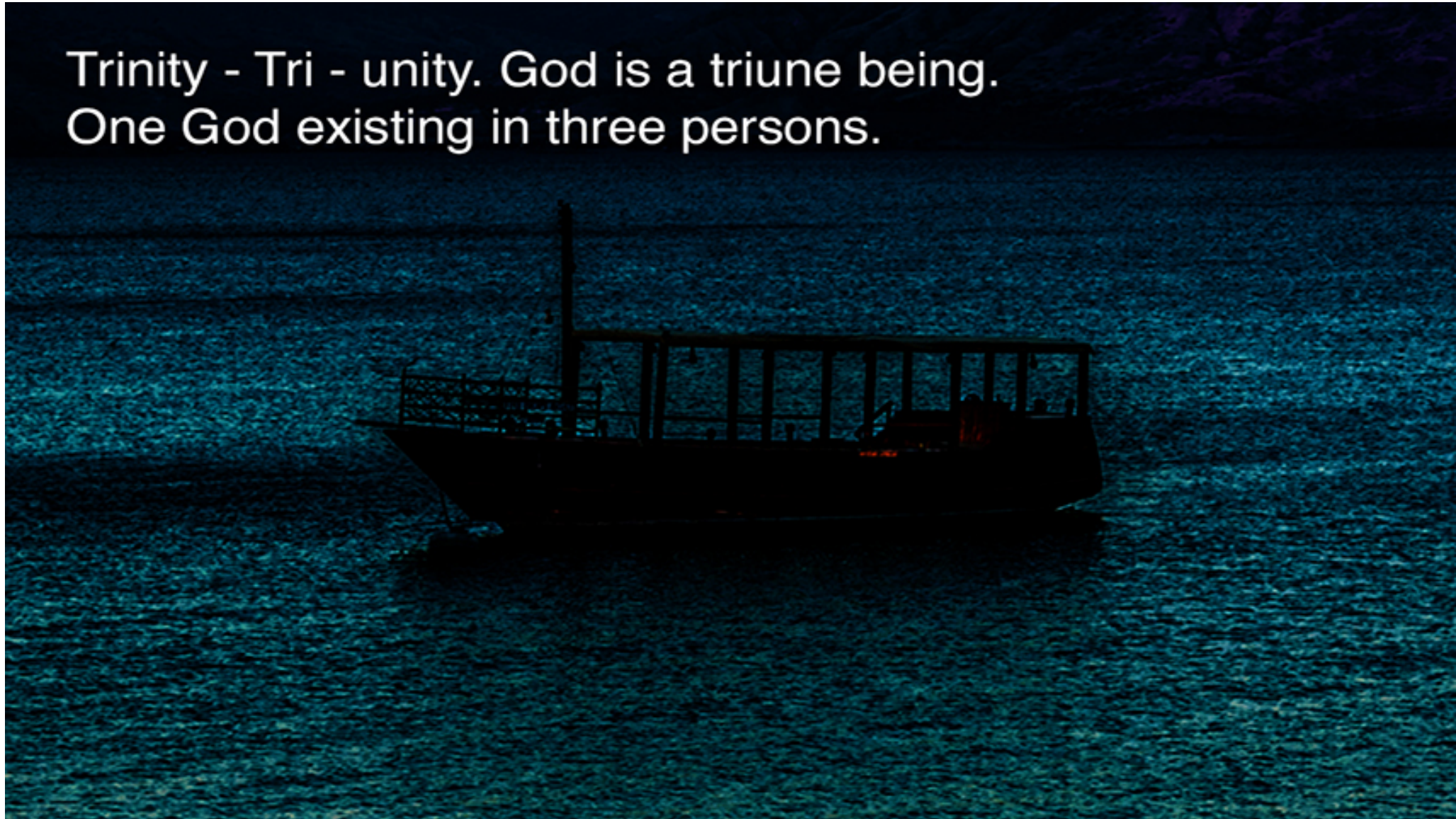
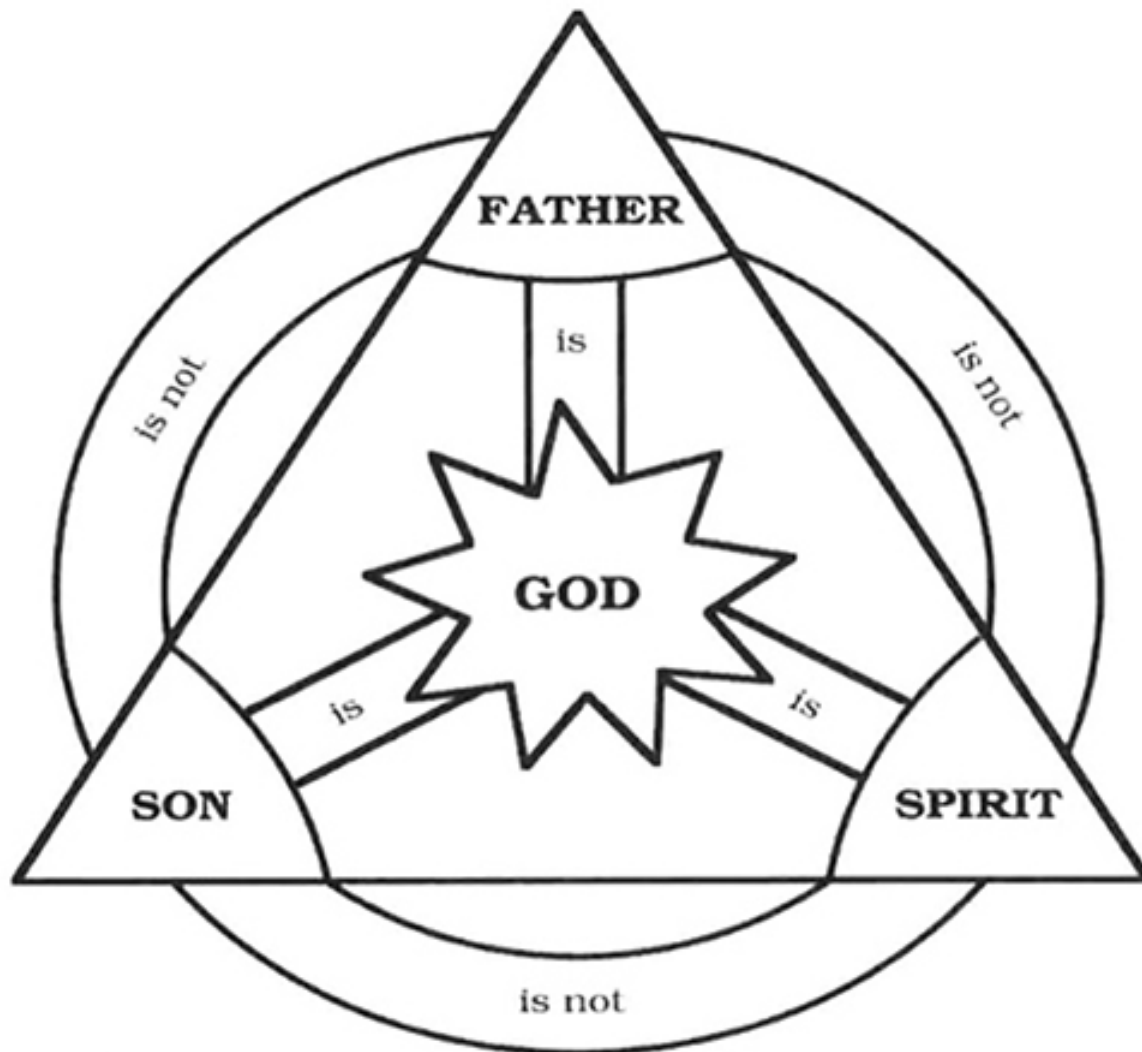

Shema - Deut. 6:4 - "Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one!

One - ἑκ-ἓν - Ek-had – compound Unity, same word used in **Genesis 1:5**: So the evening and the morning were the first day.

Exodus 26:6 and 11, the fifty gold clasps are used to hold the curtains together so the tent would be one (ἑκ-ἓν – Ek-had) - a unity (one) made up of a plurality (the many parts of the tabernacle).

Ezekiel 37:17 - two sticks of Ephraim and Judah becoming one (ἑκ-ἓν – Ek-had).

Gen22:2 -Then He said, "Take now your son, your only son Isaac,

Only - ἕν-μόνον - yach-eed, - which speaks of an absolute unity or singularity

In the Hebrew this is הָיָה הַיְהִי – ha yah, ha yah – it is a verb, to be. Meaning to exist, be in existence.
