

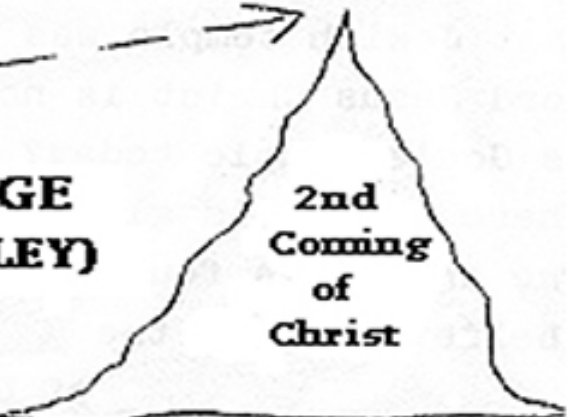
There are three aspects of Salvation:

- 1) Past:** We are saved from the penalty of Sin – Justification – free from the wrath of God. (Rom.5:1, 8:1)
- 2) Present:** We are saved from the bondage of Sin – Sanctification – this is a process as we learn to walk in the Spirit rather than the flesh. (John 13:10, 1John 1:9)
- 3) Future:** We are saved from the presence of Sin – Glorification - this is when we are in the Presence of God in our new heavenly bodies. (Rev.21:4; 1John 3:2)


