

vs 6- chief cornerstone - ἀκρογωνιαίος – akrogoniaios - placed at an extreme corner, the corner foundation stone

vs 7 - chief cornerstone - Chief - κεφαλή - kephale – the head of men, Since the loss of the head destroys life, this word is used in the phrases relating to capital and extreme punishment.

Cornerstone - γωνία – gonia - an angle:—corner, quarter.

Isaiah 28:16 Therefore thus says the Lord GOD:

“Behold, I lay in Zion a stone for a foundation,
A tried stone, a precious cornerstone, a sure foundation;

Stone – אֶבֶן - eh'·van - means building stone.

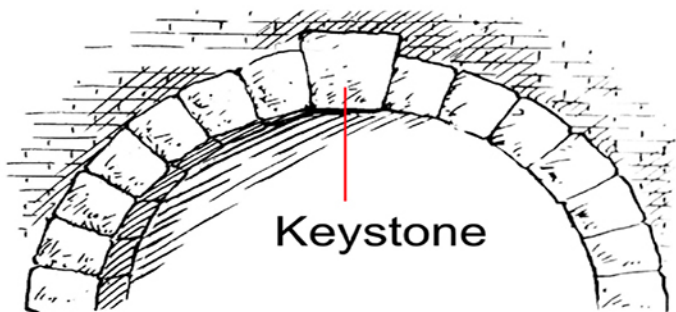
Tried – בִּחַן - bochan, bo'-khan - tested, tried, From בָּחַן - bä·khan'
meaning trial

Precious – יָקָר - yä·kär' - valuable

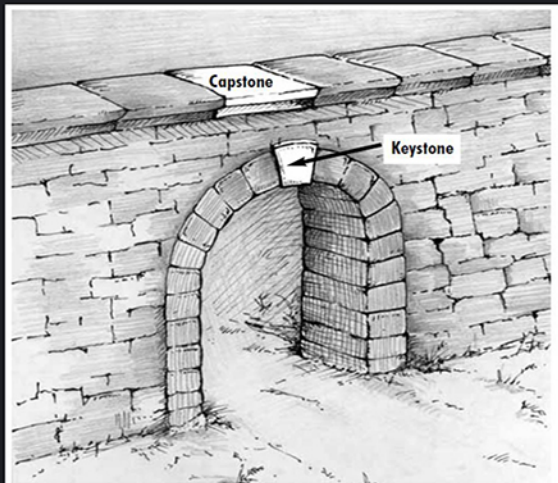
Cornerstone – פִּנָּה Pinnah - an angle; a pinnacle which means peak, apex, top.

Foundation – מוֹסֵד mü·säd' - laying of foundation, foundation-laying

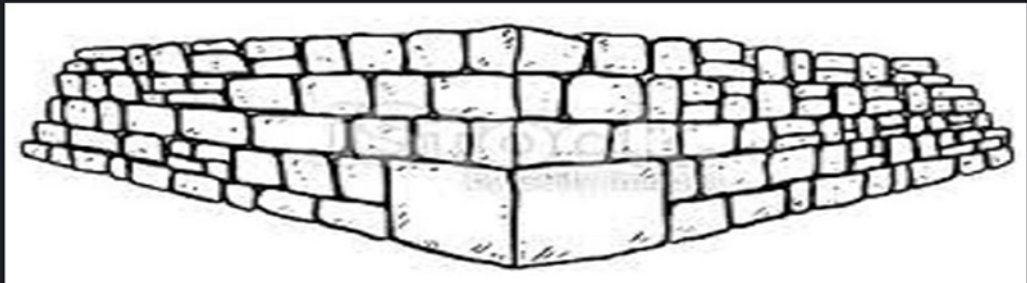
A Keystone is the wedge-shaped stone piece at the apex of a masonry vault or arch, which is the final piece placed during construction and locks all the stones into position, allowing the arch to bear weight. Although a masonry arch or vault cannot be self-supporting until the Keystone is placed, the Keystone experiences the least stress of any of the [other stones], due to its position at the apex.



A Capstone - Top stone: a stone used at the top of a wall or another structure.



A Cornerstone - In biblical times, a cornerstone was used as the foundation and standard upon which a building was constructed. Once in place, the rest of the building would conform to the angles of the cornerstone.



Capstone in Hebrew -

Cap (Head) - 7222. ראש - rōshe - head, top, summit, upper part,

Stone- 68. אבן - eh'·ven - stone from the root of בנה - bä·nä'-
meaning to build; In other words these are building stones

Matthew 21:42-44

Stone - λίθος – lee-thos - stone

Chief Cornerstone in the Greek is Kefala Gonia

Chief – κεφαλή - Kefala – means Head, supreme, prominent

Cornerstone – γωνία - Gonia – means corner, external angle

Psalm 118:22-23

Here Chief Cornerstone in the Hebrew

Stone – אֶבֶן - eh'·ven - stone from the root of בָּנָה - bä·nä'- meaning to build; In other words these are building stones

Chief – רֵאשִׁית - rōshe - head, top, summit, upper part,

Cornerstone - פִּנְיָה - pinnah -pin-naw'; an angle; by implication, a pinnacle – means peak, apex, top

So the building stone the builders rejected became the pinnacle stone, the top stone or capstone.

Matthew 21:44

Vs 44 - Wd **Broken** in the Greek is **συνθλάω** - soon-thlow; from G4862 and thlao (to crush); to dash together, i.e. shatter:—break in pieces. To fall upon the stone, will lay you prostrate upon the Rock Jesus, speaks of humility coming humbly and broken before Him

Vs 44 – Wd **Powder** - **λικμάω**- lēk-mäō to winnow, cleanse away the chaff from the grain by winnowing, to scatter, crush to pieces, to grind to powder. In other words you are destroyed, you cannot be put together again.

Romans 10:19.....

*“I will provoke you to jealousy by those who are not a **nation**,
I will move you to anger by a foolish **nation**.”*

1Cor. 1:23 but we preach Christ crucified, to the Jews a stumbling block and to the Greeks foolishness,
