



Body – Greek wd Soma – means literal body, the flesh.

Soul - Greek word Psuche - Psyche - - self, inner ife

Spirit – Greek wd Pneuma - wind, i.e. breath,

Vs 18 – Is speaking of Jesus time on the cross

Vs 19-20 Is speaking of Jesus time between His crucifixion and His resurrection

Vs 21-22 Is speaking from Jesus resurrection to heaven

Sheol – Heb. **wd - sh}owl**, *sheh-ole´*; or **IOa◇v** **shol**, *sheh-ole´*; from 7592; the **world of the dead** (as if a subterranean retreat), including its accessories and inmates: — **grave, hell, pit**

1st thing we know about Sheol is that it is the place of the Dead, both the righteous and the unrighteous goes to Sheol.

Psa. 89:48 What man can live and not see death?

Can he deliver his life from the power of the **grave?**

Again the word grave here is the Hebrew word Sheol. So then the righteous and unrighteous go to Sheol.

**2nd thing we know is that Sheol is a frightful place for the wicked,
but a place of peace for the righteous.**

Psalm. 9:17 The wicked shall be turned into hell, And all the nations that forget God.

Word Hell here is the Heb. Wd Sheol.

For the righteous Sheol was a place to look forward to, a place of peace.

Isaiah 57:1 The righteous perishes,

And no man takes it to heart;

Merciful men are taken away,

While no one considers

That the righteous is taken away from evil.

Isaiah. 57:2 *He shall enter into peace;*

They shall rest in their beds,

Each one walking in his uprightness.

3rd thing we know is that there are different levels or sections or compartments in Sheol for the wicked.

Deut. 32:22 For a fire is kindled in My anger,

And shall burn to the **lowest** hell; (Sheol)

It shall consume the earth with her increase,

And set on fire the foundations of the mountains.

4th thing we know is the direction of Sheol is always down.

Job 7:9 As the cloud disappears and vanishes away,

So he who goes **down** to the grave does not come up.

Is. 5:14 Therefore Sheol has enlarged itself

And opened its mouth beyond measure;

Their glory and their multitude and their pomp,

And he who is jubilant, shall **descend** into it.

5th thing we know about Sheol is that it is a place of consciousness.

God speaking through Isaiah the prophet in proclaiming judgment on Babylon and the King of Babylon it says..

**Is. 14:9 “Hell from beneath is excited about you,
 To meet you at your coming;
 It stirs up the dead for you,
 All the chief ones of the earth;
 It has raised up from their thrones
 All the kings of the nations.**

**Is. 14:10 They all shall speak and say to you:
 “Have you also become as weak as we?
 Have you become like us?**

**Is. 14:11 Your pomp is brought down to Sheol,
 And the sound of your stringed instruments;
 The maggot is spread under you,
 And worms cover you.**

Psa. 16:10 **For You will not leave my soul in Sheol,
Nor will You allow Your Holy One to see corruption.**

Peter quoting this same verse in the book of Acts in speaking of Jesus

Acts 2:27 ***For You will not leave my soul in Hades,
Nor will You allow Your Holy One to see corruption.***

So then Sheol and Hades is the same place.
