 - *worship Him**

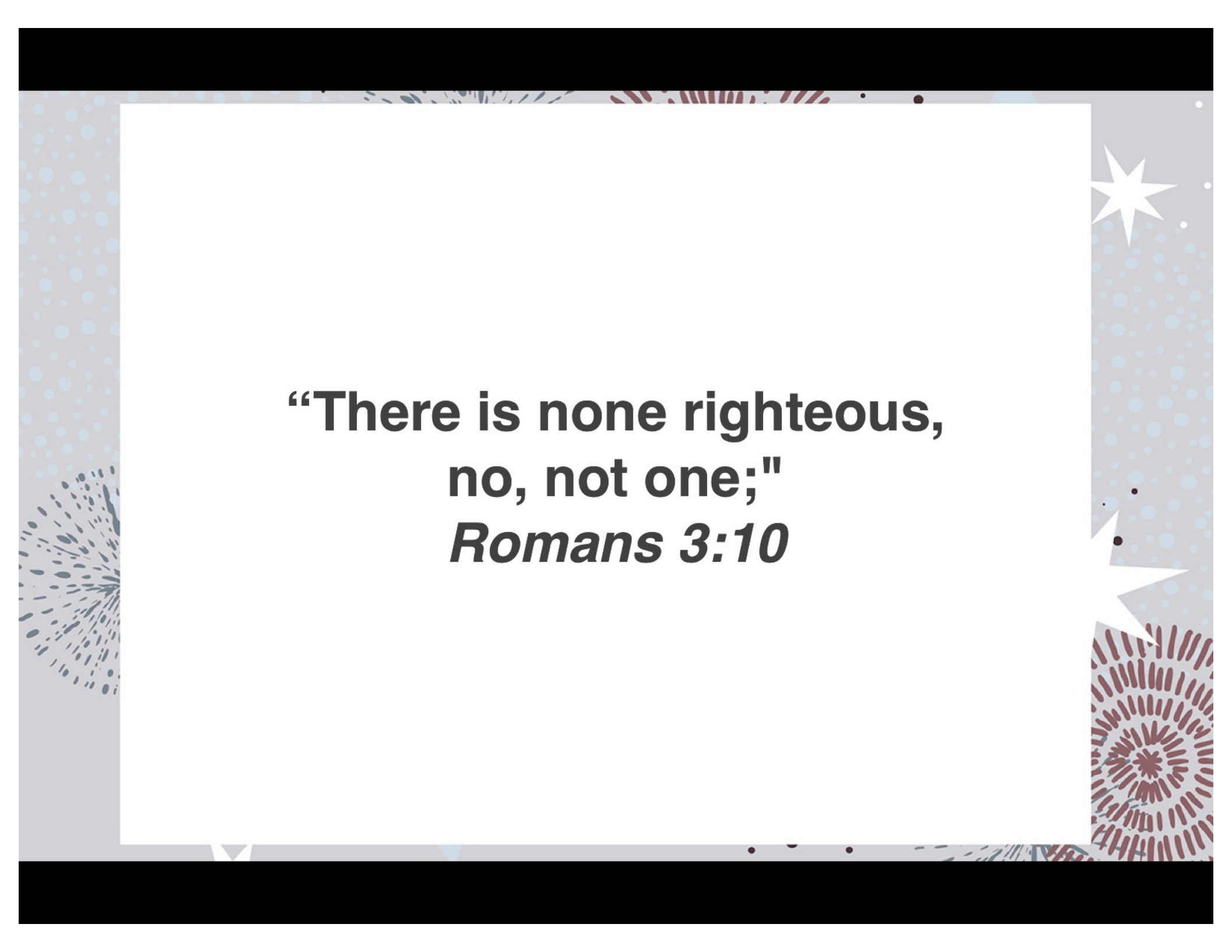

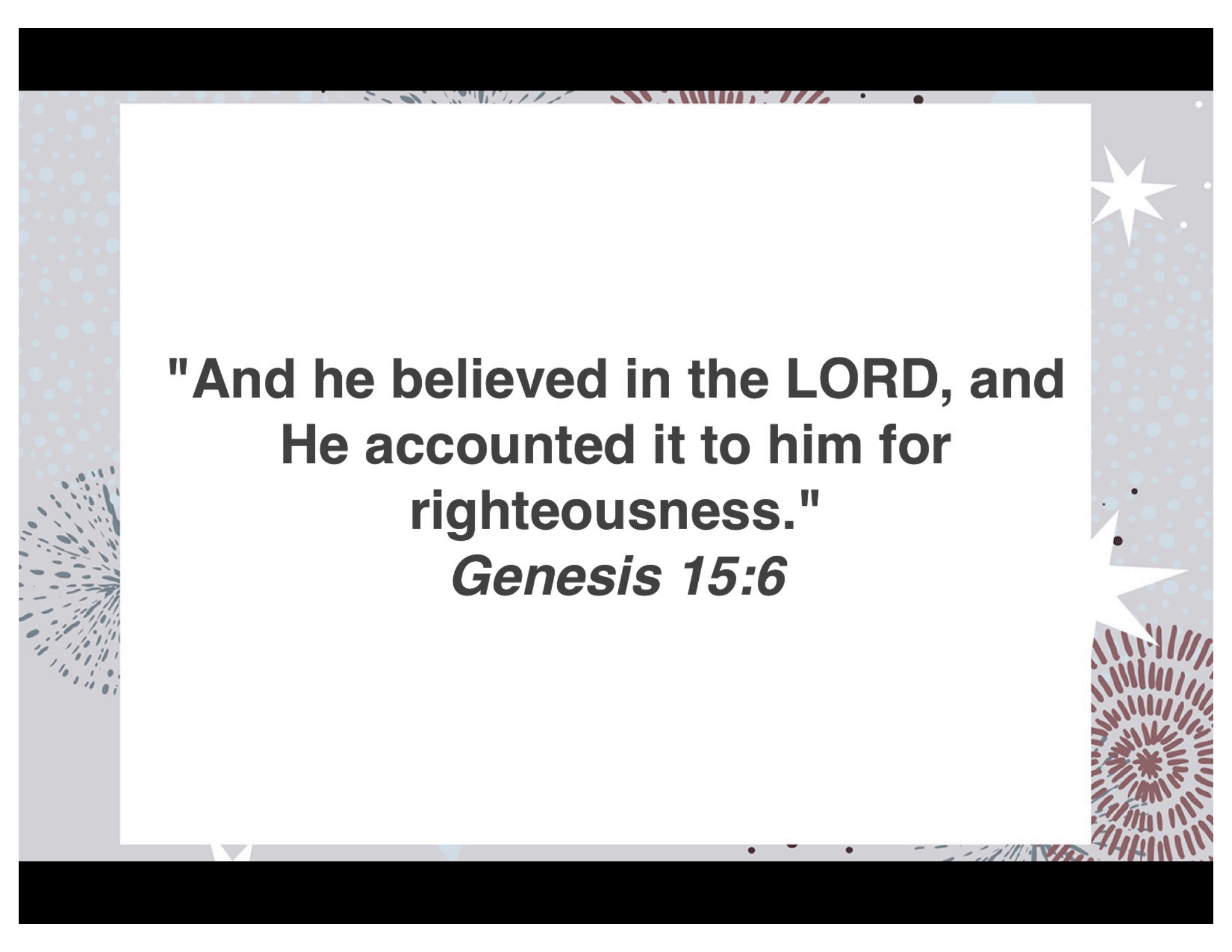
