**SUPPLICATION:** *3-5 MIN OR MORE*

**INTERCEDE:** *3-5 MIN OR MORE*

*(1 Timothy 2:1)*

**For family, neighbors, friends, and co workers.**

**Pray for their salvation or any other needs you are aware of.**






**LISTEN:** *3-5 MIN OR MORE*

*(Psalm 46:10)*

**Be still and know that He is God, listen and let God speak to you. Sometimes a name may pop into your head and that is God telling you to pray for that person.**





**READ THE WORD:** *REMAINING TIME*

*(John 14:26, John 16:13)*

**Ask God through the holy Spirit to speak to you  
and give you understanding through the word.**

## **MATTHEW 26:36-41**

**Then Jesus came with them to a place called Gethsemane, and said to the disciples, “Sit here while I go and pray over there.”**

## **MATTHEW 26:36-41**

**Then He came to the disciples and found them sleeping, and said to Peter, “What? Could you not watch with Me one hour?”**





**MATTHEW 26:36-41**

**Watch and pray, lest you enter into temptation.**

**The spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak.**





**ADORATION:** *3-5 MIN OR MORE*

*(Psalm 100:4)*

**Give praise, Thanksgiving to God. You are alone so  
sing your favorite worship song to Him.**



**CONFESSION:** *3-5 MIN OR MORE*

*(1 John 1:9)*

**Ask God to show you those things you need to confess. Ask God if you are bitter towards anyone or angry at anyone or if you have sinned against anyone. Then confess it and ask for forgiveness.**
