

**“Flesh” – σάρξ – (sä'rks)**

**The sensuous nature of man, "the animal nature"; carnal animal nature with cravings which incite to sin.**

“Lust” – ἐπιθυμία – (e-pe-thü-me'-ä)

Desire, craving, longing, desire for what is  
forbidden, lust.

**“Uncleanliness” – μιαισμός – (me-ä-smo's)**

**Act of defiling, defilement, pollution – in other words it is "the act of defiling," the process in which you become defiled” meaning you are participating in those unclean things.**

**“Despise” – ΚΑΤΑΦΡΟΝΕΩ – (kä-tä-fro-ne'-o)**

**Despise, disdain, think little or nothing of. In other words to think and look down upon to see no value in it.**

**“Authority” – κυριότης – (kü-re-o'-tas)**

**Dominion, power, lordship. Either divine angelic messengers or human.**

“Presumptuous” – τολμητής

**Audacious, impudent, shameless and irreverent.**

**“Self willed” – αὐθάδης – (au-thä'-das)**

**Self-pleasing, self-willed, arrogant. In other words this speaks of one who is dominated by self-interest, and inconsiderate of others.**

**“Speak Evil” – βλασφημέω – (blä-sfa-me'-o)**

**Which is where we get our English word for  
Blasphemy and it means speak reproachfully, rail at,  
revile, be spoken evil of.**

## “Dignitaries” – δόξα – (do'-ksä)

**Which means glories. Primarily signifies an opinion, estimate, and hence, the honor resulting from a good opinion. It is used of the nature and acts of God in self-manifestation, i.e., what He essentially is and does, as shown in whatever way he reveals Himself in these respects, and particularly in the person of Christ, in whom essentially His "glory" has shone forth and always will.**

*(John 17:5, 24; Heb. 1:3)*

“Carouse” – τρυφή – (trü-fa')

**Softness, effeminate, luxurious living.**

“Spots” – σπῖλος – (spe'-los)

**A fault, moral blemish.**

**“Blemishes” – μῶμος – (mo'-mos)**

**Blot, disgrace.**

**Thus speaking of these false teachers as having moral faults and disgraceful in how they behave.**

**These are spots in your love feasts, while they feast with you without fear, serving only themselves.**
