

“Beloved” – יְדֻדָּהּ – (yed·ed)

Well loved or one beloved

“Benjamin” – בְּנֵי־מִיִן – (bin·yā·mene)

Son of the right hand

Ben – Oni – son of my sorrow.

Is a type, a picture of Christ ministry here on earth

Benjamin – son of my right hand.

Is a type, a picture of Christ in heaven seated at the right hand of the Father.

**The LORD said to my Lord, Sit at My right hand, Till I
make Your enemies Your footstool. (*Psalm 110:1*)**

**The LORD said to my Lord, 'Sit at My right hand, Till I
make Your enemies Your footstool' (*Matthew 22:44*)**

Jesus said to him, “It is as you said. Nevertheless, I say to you, hereafter you will see the Son of Man sitting at the right hand of the Power, and coming on the clouds of heaven.”

**Another 13 times in the N.T. that Jesus is now seated

“Beloved” – ἀγαπητός – (ä-gä-pa-to's)

**Esteemed, given great value, honored,
dear, favourite.**

“Stir” – διεγείρω – (de-e-ga'-ro)

To wake up, awaken, arouse (from sleep)

“Pure” – εἰλικρινής – (a-le-kre-na's)

Sincere, unsullied.

“Mindful” – μνᾶομαι – (mnä'-o-mi)

To remind.

“Scoffers” – ἐμπαίκτης – (em-pi'k-tas)

A mocker.

O.T. Prophets – *wrote about the Messiah coming to establish His kingdom on earth.*

N.T. Apostles - *wrote about the Messiah, Jesus, Coming for His Church, the Rapture of the saints to take to heaven before the 7 year tribulation period which ends with Jesus coming back to rule on the earth for 1,000 years.*

**To place together, to set in the same place,
or hold together.**

**In other words Jesus has set in place,
or holds together creation.**

“Slack” – βραδύνω – (brä-dü'-no)

Means to delay, to be slow.
