Tamar (vs 3) - The one who played the harlot with Judah.

Rahab (vs 5) - The prostitute in Jericho who hid Joshua's spies and her and her family was spared when Israel invaded Jericho.

Ruth (vs 5) - The Moabite daughter in law of Naomi who marries her kinsman redeemer Boaz.

Bathsheba (vs 6) - The one who had been the wife of Uriah. David commits adultery with her and it was from her that king Solomon was born.

2 of them were Harlots (Tamar, Rahab)

1 Committed adultery (Bathsheba)

2 were Gentiles (Rahab , Ruth)
