Philip's wife who became
Antipas' wife – Matt 14:3-6

Herod Agrippa II

Every Acts reference
to "Agrippa" (chap 25-26)

Bernice

"Wife" of Agrippa II

Drusilla

Wife of Gov. Felix
(Acts 24:24)

Philip ruled for 37 years and died in the 20th year of Caesar Tiberias which was in 33/34 A.D.

33/34 AD - 37 years = 4/3 BC

So Jesus birth was somewhere before Herod's death, 4,5,6 BC

**Then Herod, when he saw that he was
deceived by the wise men, was
exceedingly angry;**

MATTHEW 2:16

And he sent forth and put to death all the male children who were in Bethlehem and in all its districts, from two years old and under,

MATTHEW 2:16

**According to the time which he had
determined from the wise men.**

MATTHEW 2:16

If Philip ruled for 37 years and died in the 22 year of Caesar Tiberias then:

35/36 Ad - 37 years = 2/1 BC

Now Jesus birth can be either 2,3,4 BC

**Now Jesus Himself began His ministry at
about thirty years of age**

LUKE 3:23

**Now as He drew near, He saw the city and
wept over it,**

LUKE 19:41

**Saying, “If you had known, even you,
especially in this your day, the things that
make for your peace! But now they are
hidden from your eyes.**

LUKE 19:42

**For days will come upon you when your
enemies will build an embankment around you,
surround you and close you in on every side,**

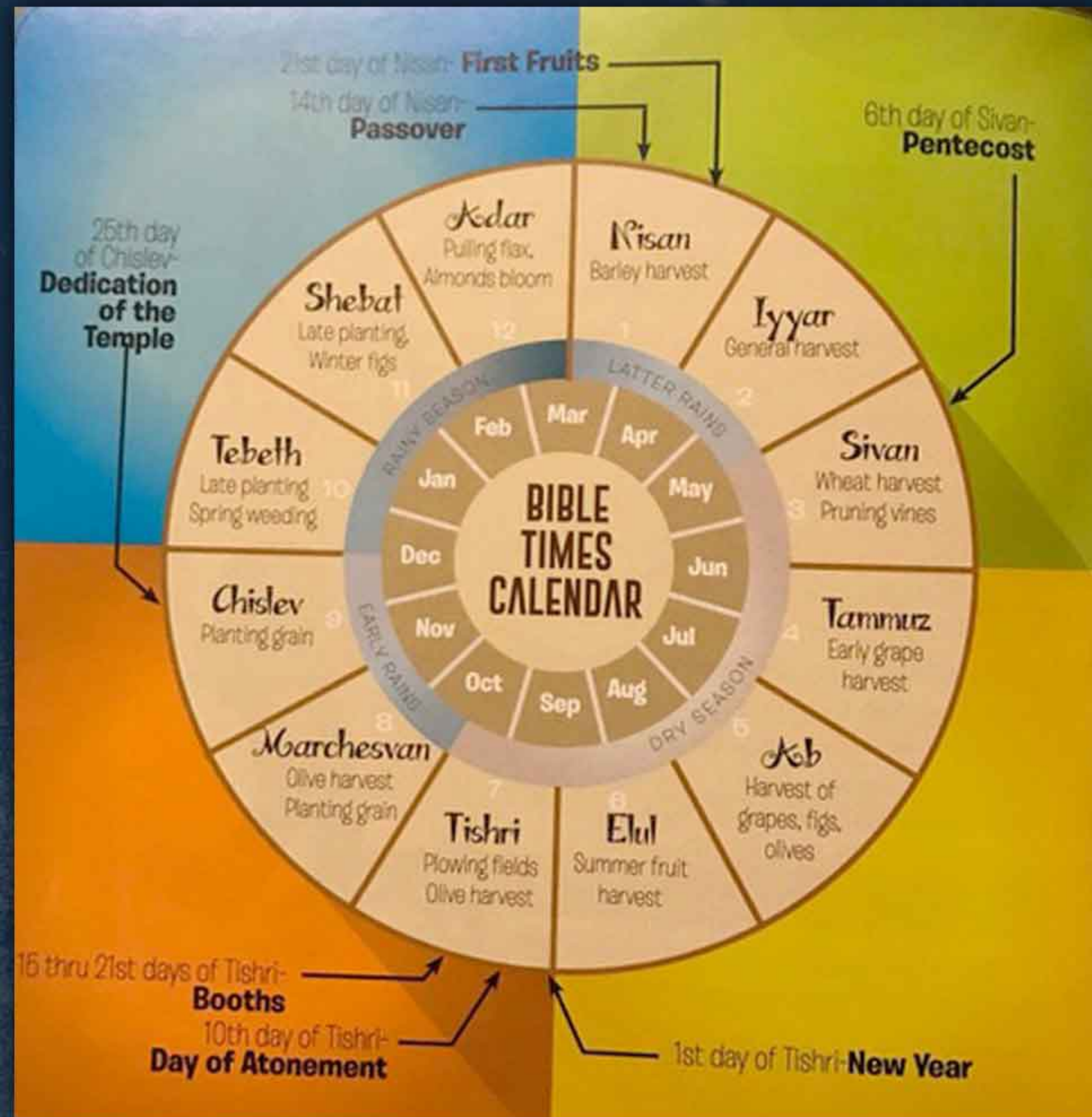
LUKE 19:43

“Signs” – אִּוֹת – (oth)

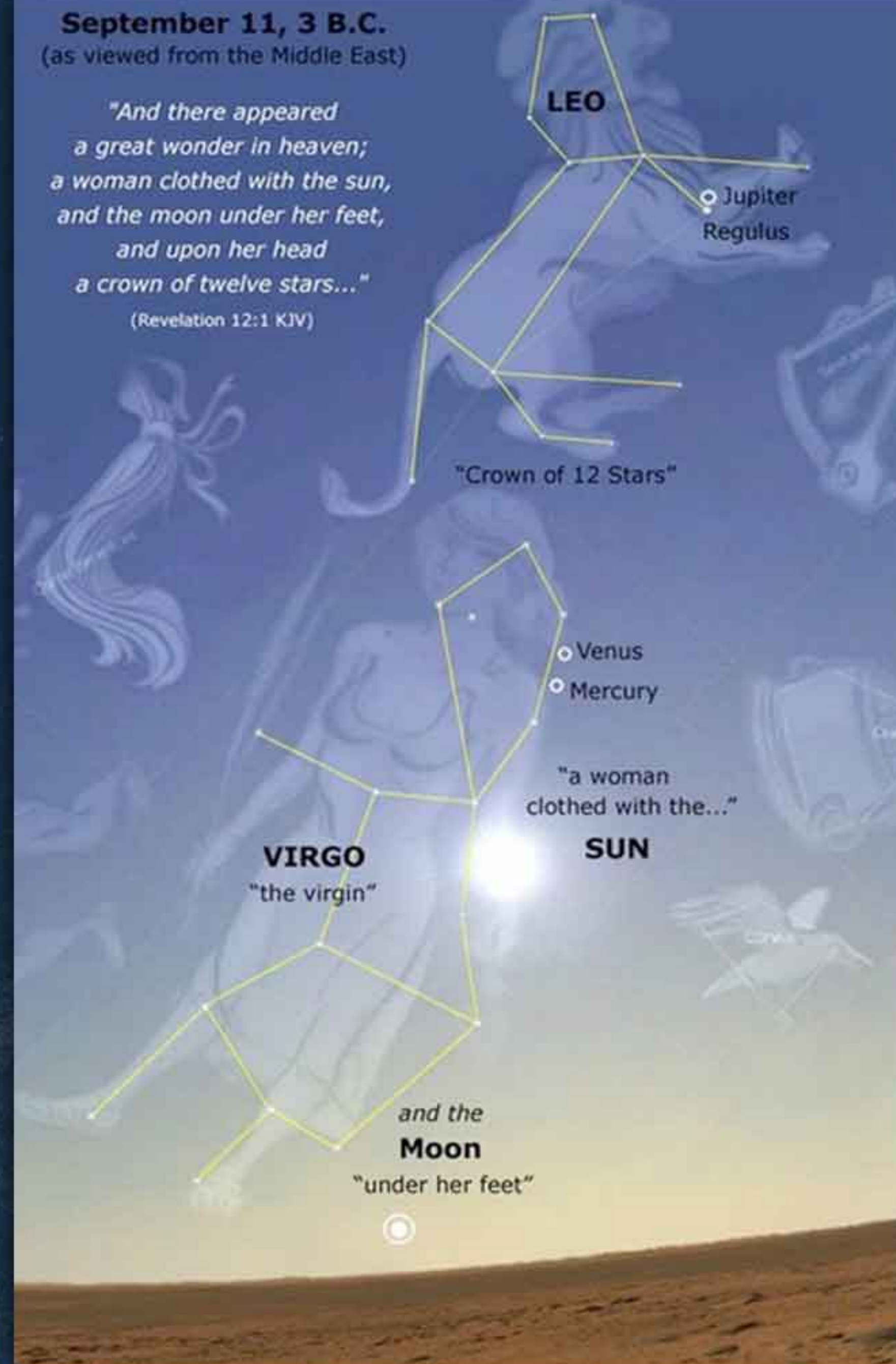
Sign, signal, a distinguishing mark, banner,
remembrance, miraculous sign, omen, warning, proof

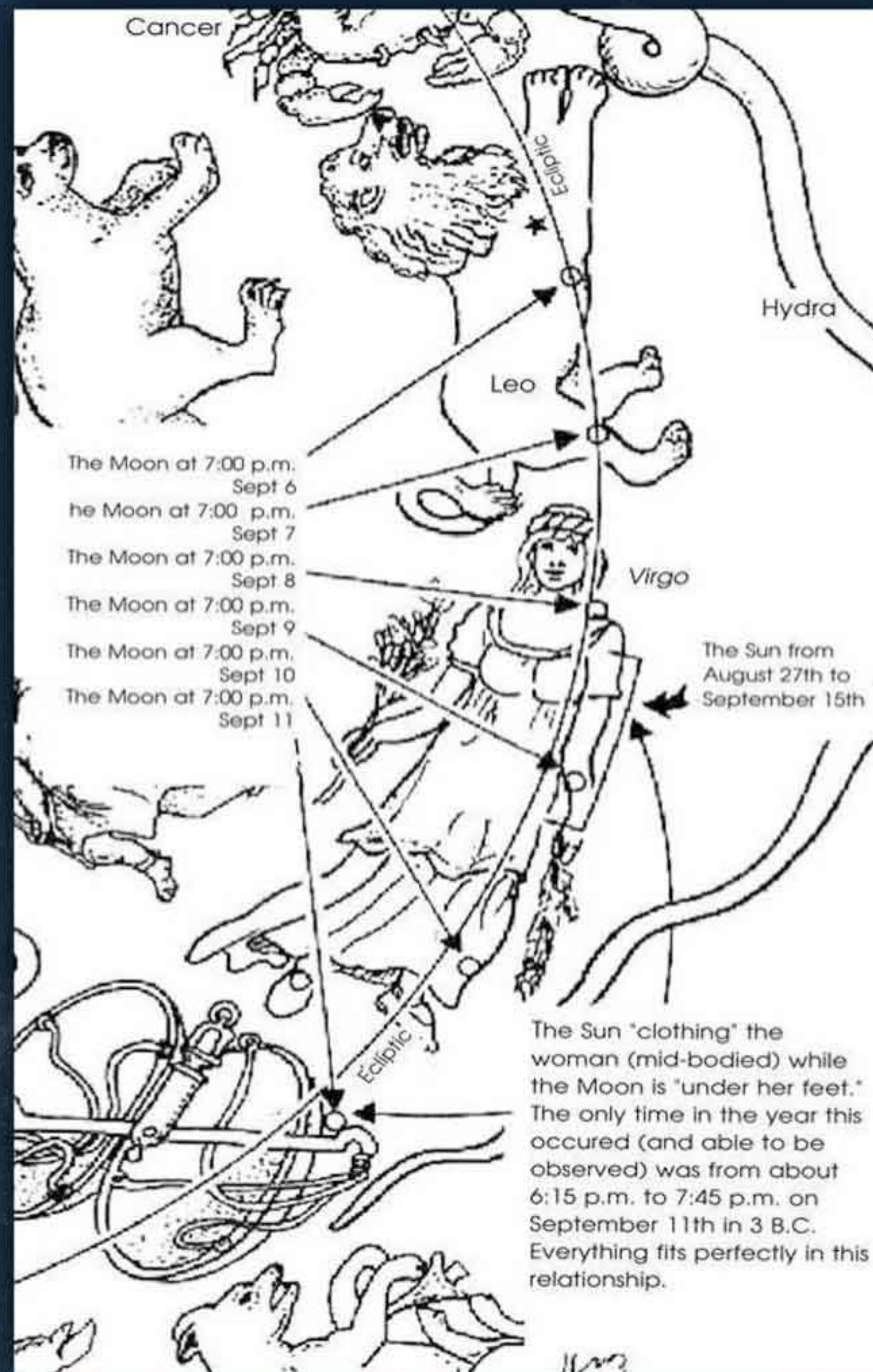
Is it possible that this statement in Rev.12 is actually a

(Revelation 12:1 KJV)

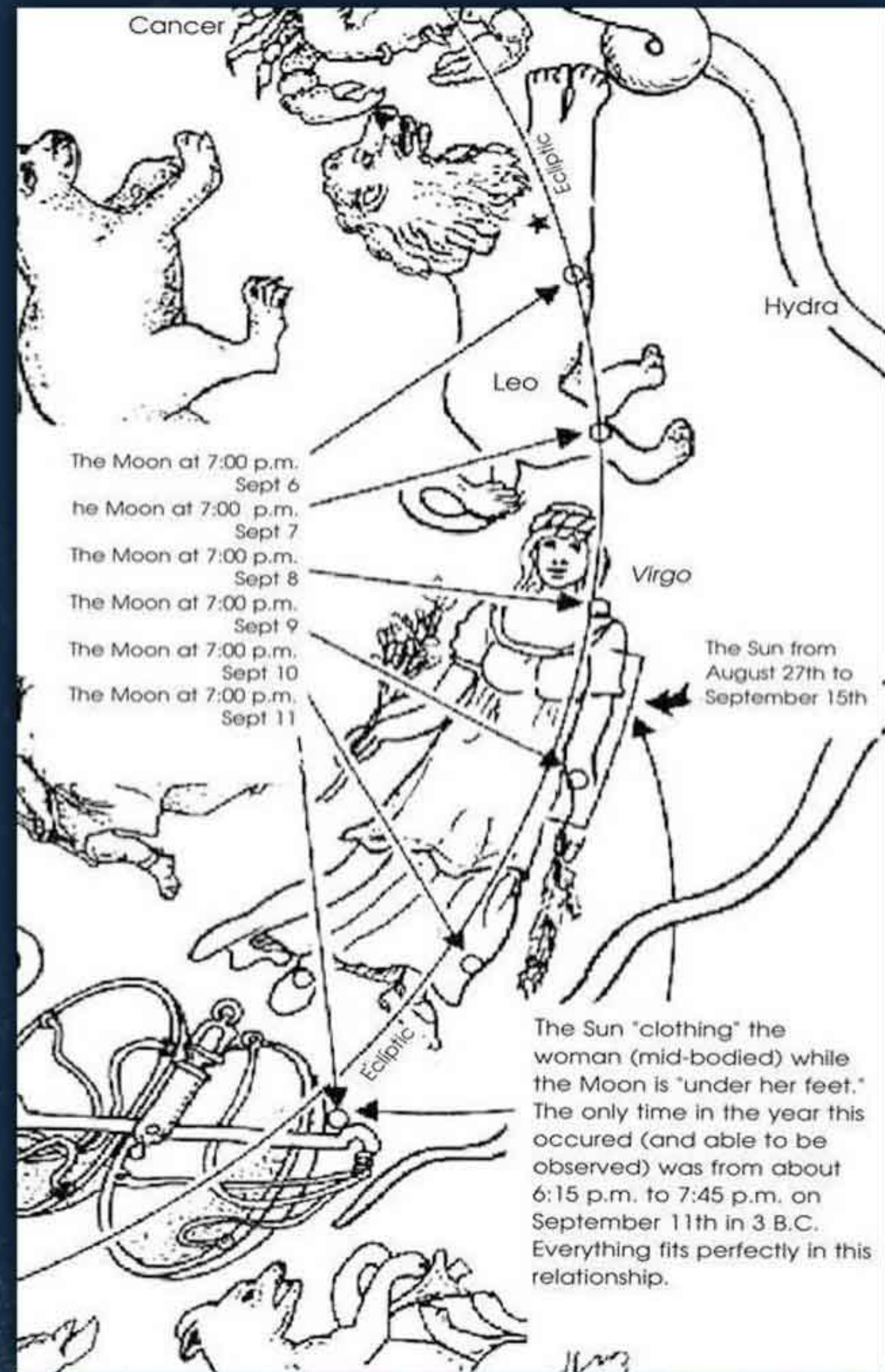
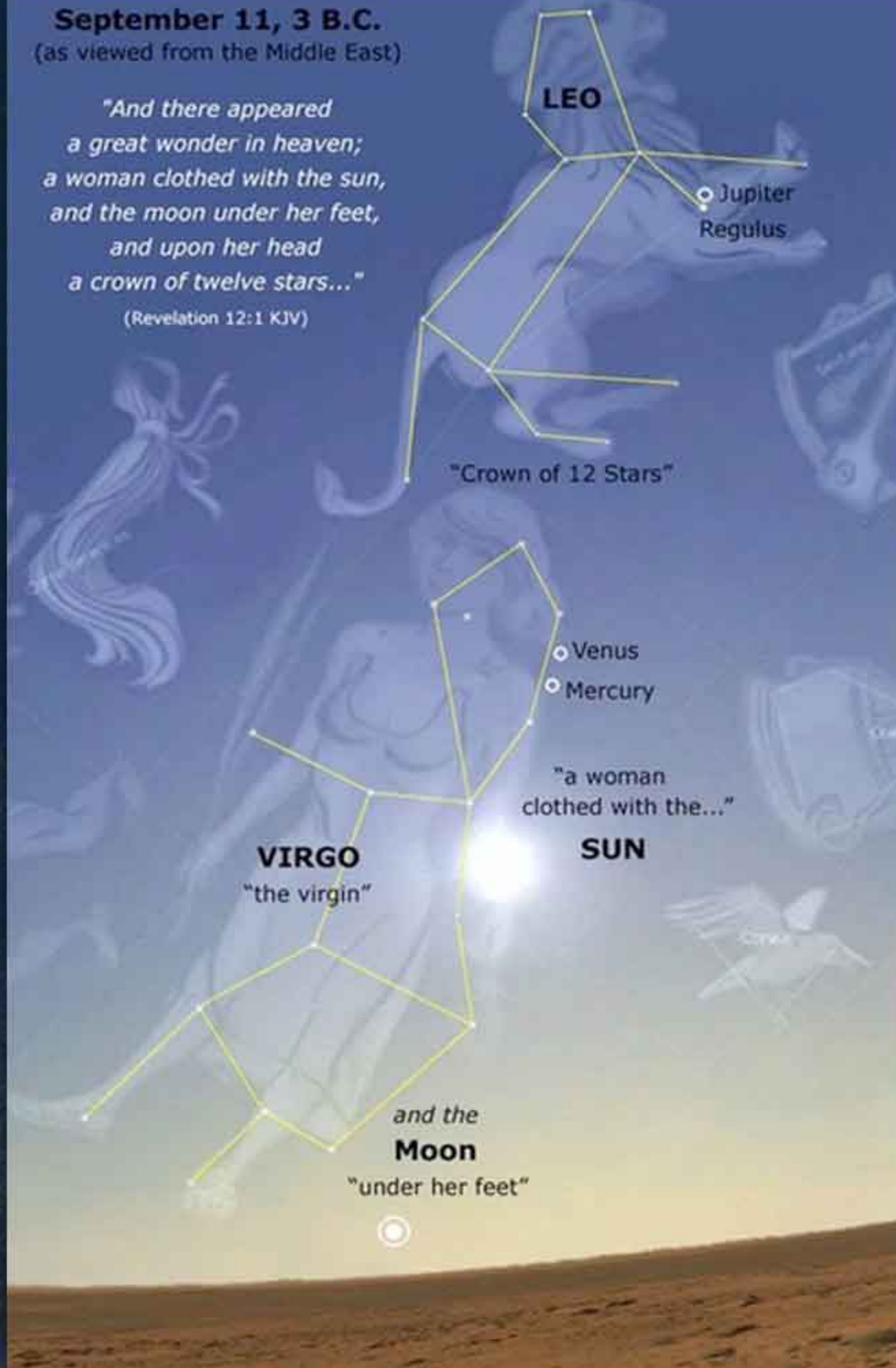




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**Now there were in the same country
