Around – περιλάμπω (pe-re-lä'm-po)

Declare – סָפַר (sa-fare')

A primitive root; properly, to score with a mark as a tally or record, i.e. (by implication) to inscribe, and also to enumerate; intensively, to recount, i.e. celebrate:—commune, (ac-)count; declare, number, + penknife, reckon, scribe, shew forth, speak, talk, tell (out), writer.

Good tidings – εὐαγγελίζω (yü-än-ge-le'-zo)

Bring good news, to announce glad tidings, In the NT used especially of the glad tidings of the coming kingdom of God, and of the salvation to be obtained in it through Christ, and of what relates to this salvation

Great – μέγας (meg-as)

Great as in mass and weight, compass and extent: large, spacious, numerous, large, abundant

Joy – χαρά (khar-ah)

Cheerfulness, calm delight, gladness


Meaning all.

Meaning people in general, means all humans everywhere.


Savior – σωτήρ (So–tare) – Deliverer

Means to save or make safe, to deliver or protect, to heal and make whole. It is also where we get the word soteriology meaning the study of the savior or salvation.

Saying – λέγω (le-go)

Glory – (doxa) – from 1380

It is more of an opinion that they recognize God's Genius, His majesty in this expression of His Love of sending down His Son Jesus to rescue mankind and bring mankind peace.
