Triple “I” Doctrine – *inspired, infallible, inerrant*

“But holy men of God spoke as they were moved by the Holy Spirit.”

2 Peter 1:21

Turn Back

Inspired – God breathed.

“All Scripture is given by inspiration of God. . .”

2 Timothy 3:16

Turn Back

Infallible – no potential or ability to err, totally reliable, cannot contradict itself.

“... it is impossible for God to lie ...”

Hebrews 6:18

Turn Back

Inerrant – technically correct, free from falsehood and deceit, wholly true.

“For assuredly, I say to you, till heaven and earth pass away, one jot or one tittle will by no means pass from the law till all is fulfilled.”

Matthew 5:18
