He would be God and man. (Ch.9:6)

Messiah would heal the sick. (Ch.35:5-6)

He would be rejected by the Jews. (Ch.49:7)

He would be whipped and scourged. (Ch.50:6)

Messiah would be the perfect sacrifice. (Ch.53)

For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many.

MARK 10:45

**Jesus lifted up as a
Sin offering**

And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of Man be lifted up,

JOHN 3:14

And I, if I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all peoples to Myself.

JOHN 12:32

**His exalted position after
His death and resurrection.**

**This Jesus God has raised up, of which
we are all witnesses.**

ACTS 2:32

Therefore being exalted to the right hand of God, and having received from the Father the promise of the Holy Spirit, He poured out this which you now see and hear.

ACTS 2:33

**Therefore God also has highly exalted
Him and given Him the name which is
above every name,**

ISAIAH 50:6

In the ancient Greek and it is a cry of victory.

Meaning paid in full. It has been accomplished, to bring to a close, to make an end to. All that was required for the penalty of sin has been accomplished...paid in full.
