

지그발 Rest – (sha-vat)

To repose, i.e. desist from exertion; used in many implied relations (causative, figurative or specific): It is where we get the word Sabbath.

"Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy.

Six days you shall labor and do all your work,

But the seventh day is the Sabbath of the LORD your God. In it you shall do no work: you, nor your son, nor your daughter, nor your male servant, nor your female servant, nor your cattle, nor your stranger who is within your gates.

For in six days the LORD made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and all that is in them, and rested the seventh day. Therefore the LORD blessed the Sabbath day and hallowed it.

키글 Blessed – barak (baw-rack')

To kneel; by implication to bless God (as an act of adoration), and (vice-versa) man (as a benefit); also (by euphemism) to curse (God or the king, as treason):

Sanctified – qadash (kaw-daysh')

To be (causatively, make, pronounce or observe as) clean (ceremonially or morally):

5 Sabbath laws according to scripture:

- 1 The Sabbath was to be kept from Sunset to Sunset (Lev. 23:23)
- 2 No Burden was to be carried (Jer. 17:21)
- 3 No fire kindled (Ex. 35:3)
- 4 No Cooking is to be done (Ex. 16:23)
- **5** The penalty for breaking the Sabbath was death. (Num. 15)

Now therefore, why do you test God by putting a yoke on the neck of the disciples which neither our fathers nor we were able to bear?

But we believe that through the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ we shall be saved in the same manner as they."

No mention of Sabbath Day of Rest:

- 1 Worship the Lord only 1st commandment mentioned 50 times (Matt:4:11; Phil.3:3; Rev.19:10)
- 2 Idolatry do not worship idols 2nd commandment mentioned 12 times. (Acts 15:29; 1 John 5:21; Rev.2:14)
- 3 Profanity using the Lord's name in vain 3rd commandment mentioned 4 times. (Rom.2:24; 1 Tim.6:1; Rev.13:6)

No mention of Sabbath Day of Rest:

- 4 Honoring of Parents 5th commandment mentioned 6 times. (Matt. 19:19; Mark 10:19; Eph. 6:2)

 5 Murder You should not murder 6th commandment mentioned 6 times. (Mark 10:19; Rom. 13:9; James 2:11)
- 6 Adultery do not commit adultery 7th commandment mentioned 12 times (Mark 10:19; Rom. 13:9; Gal.5:19)

No mention of Sabbath Day of Rest:

- 7 Do not steal 8th commandment mentioned 4 times (Matt. 19:18; Rom. 2; 21; Eph. 4:29)
- 8 Bearing false witness 9th commandment mentioned 4 times (Matt. 19:18; Luke 18:20; Rom. 13:19)
- 9 Do not Covet 10th commandment mentioned 9 times (Rom.7:7; Eph.5:3; Col.3:5)

And He said, "What comes out of a man, that defiles a man.

For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed evil thoughts, adulteries, fornications, murders,

thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, lewdness, an evil eye, blasphemy, pride, foolishness.

All these evil things come from within and defile a man."

And even as they did not like to retain God in their knowledge, God gave them over to a debased mind, to do those things which are not fitting; Being filled with all unrighteousness, sexual immorality, wickedness, covetousness, maliciousness; full of envy, murder, strife, deceit, evil-mindedness; they are whisperers, Backbiters, haters of God, violent, proud, boasters, inventors of evil things, disobedient to parents,

Undiscerning, untrustworthy, unloving, unforgiving, unmerciful;

Who, knowing the righteous judgment of God, that those who practice such things are deserving of death, not only do the same but also approve of those who practice them.

Do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived. Neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor homosexuals, nor sodomites,

Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners will inherit the kingdom of God.

Now the works of the flesh are evident, which are: adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lewdness,

Idolatry, sorcery, hatred, contentions, jealousies, outbursts of wrath, selfish ambitions, dissensions, heresies,

Envy, murders, drunkenness, revelries, and the like; of which I tell you beforehand, just as I also told you in time past, that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.

But know this, that in the last days perilous times will come:

For men will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy,

Unloving, unforgiving, slanderers, without self-control, brutal, despisers of good,

Traitors, headstrong, haughty, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God,

So let no one judge you in food or in drink, or regarding a festival or a new moon or sabbaths,

Which are a shadow of things to come, but the substance is of Christ.

Let no one cheat you of your reward, taking delight in false humility and worship of angels, intruding into those things which he has not seen, vainly puffed up by his fleshly mind, Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.

Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.

For My yoke is easy and My burden is light."
