REVELATION 20:2

נַחֲשׁ

Serpent - (nachash) - serpent or snake and comes from the root: to hiss, whisper a magic spell, to prognosticate, enchanter etc.

נְחֹשֶׁת

Bronze - (necho -sheth) - Bronze or Copper

For what the law could not do in that it was weak through the flesh, God did by sending His own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, on account of sin: He condemned sin in the flesh,

JOHN 3:14.

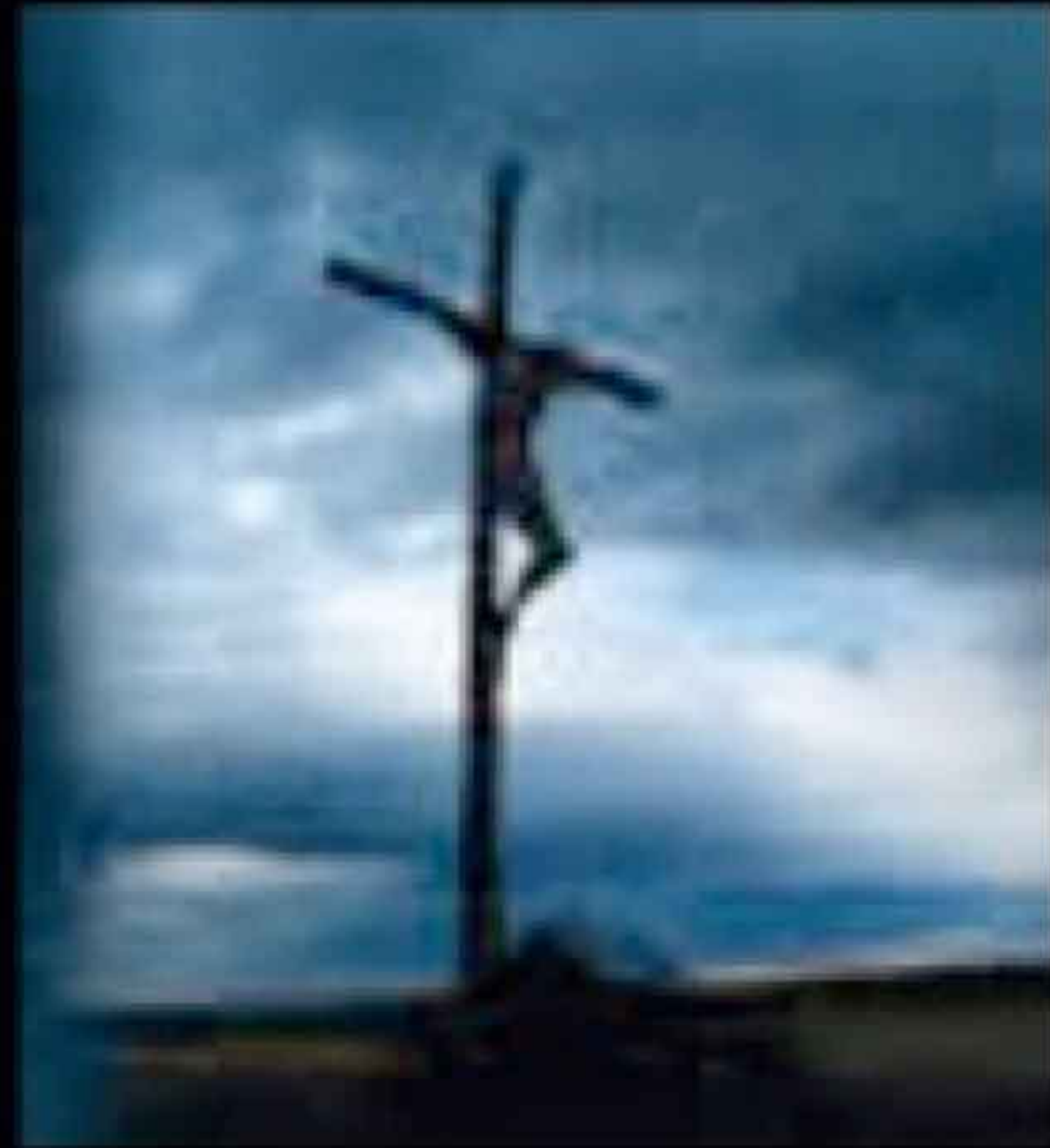


AS Moses lifted

אָכַל

Freely - Eat it all, surely, freely. In other words surely you can eat all the other fruits from all the other trees.

He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things?

מִוֹת תָּמוּת

Die Die - (muth tamuth) - Die said twice to emphasize that you will surely die. It is certain that you will die.

- **Temptation to sin also questions God's motives**
- **Temptation to sin always promises personal benefits through disobedience.**
- **Personal benefits through disobedience to what God has said.**
- **Temptation to sin appeals to our base desires**

For all that is in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life—is not of the Father but is of the world.

1 JOHN 2:16

- 1. Appeals to the flesh – bodily senses** **The lust of the flesh**
- 2. Appeals to emotions and desires, it was pleasant to the eyes** **The lust of the eyes**
- 3. Appeals to intelligence desired to make one wise or like God** **The pride of life**
