**Verse 1**

**... and she again bare his brother: Abel**

**Verse 2**

**Since brother and Able is speaking of the same person, so is man and The Lord (YHWH) speaking of the same person.**

**קַיִן**

**Cain - (kay yin) - possession or to aquire.  
Thus I have acquired or posses the seed  
who will bruise the head of Satan.**

**הַבֵּל**

**Able - (heh – vel) - Breath or vanity.**

**I loathe my life; I would not live  
forever. Let me alone, for my days  
are but a breath.**

**JOB 7:16**

**Man is like a breath; his days are like a passing shadow.**

**PSALMS 144:4**

**The LORD reigns; let the peoples  
tremble! he dwells between the  
cherubim; let the earth be moved!**

**PSALMS 99:1**

**"O LORD of hosts, God of Israel, the One who dwells between the cherubim, You are God, You alone, of all the kingdoms of the earth. You have made heaven and earth.**

**ISAIAH 37:16**

**Abel - The Way of Faith - is God's way**

**Cain - My own way - the way of Satan**

**By faith Abel offered to God a more excellent sacrifice than Cain, through which he obtained witness that he was righteous, God testifying of his gifts; and through it he being dead still speaks.**

**So then faith comes by hearing, and  
hearing by the word of God.**

**Sin - (khet-ta- ha) - from the root word -  
חָטָא - khaw-taw – to sin, miss, miss the  
way or miss the mark as is the definition  
in the Greek.**

**רַבֵּץ**

**Lies - (raw- vats) - to weigh you down, to cause you to lie down, meaning underneath.**

**תְּשׁוּקָה**

**Desire - (te shoo kah) - Desire, longing or craving**

**Therefore the wisdom of God also said, 'I will send them prophets and apostles, and some of them they will kill and persecute,'**

**LUKE 11:49**

**That the blood of all the prophets which  
was shed from the foundation of the  
world may be required of this  
generation,**

**LUKE 11:50**

**From the blood of Abel to the blood of Zechariah who perished between the altar and the temple. Yes, I say to you, it shall be required of this generation.**

**Not as Cain who was of the wicked one and murdered his brother. And why did he murder him? Because his works were evil and his brother's righteous.**

**Blood - (dom) - Used here It is in the plural noun form. Implying many drops of blood shed.**

**Precious in the sight of the LORD is the death of His saints.**

**Moreover God said to Moses, "Thus you shall say to the children of Israel: 'The LORD God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, has sent me to you.**
