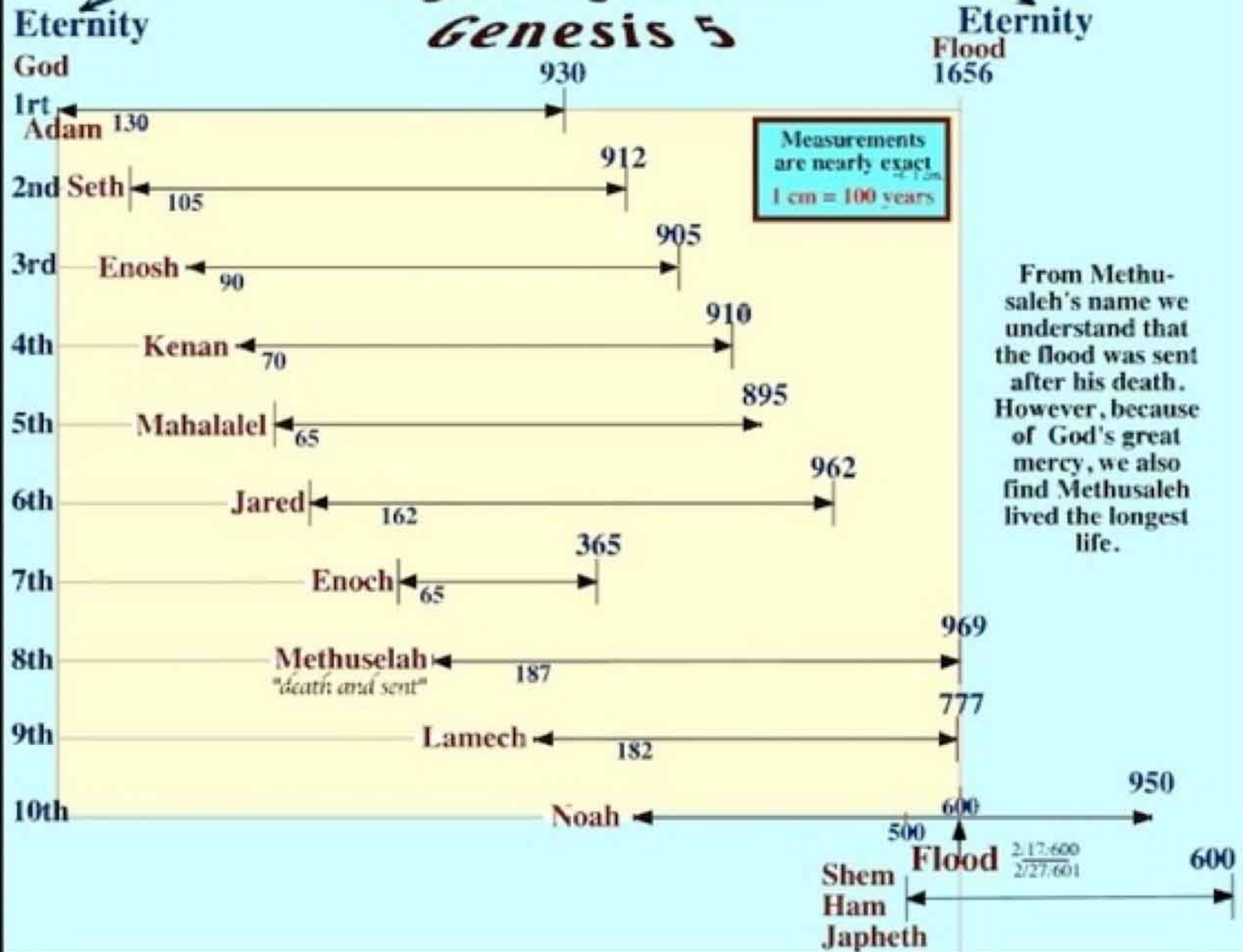


GENESIS

Genesis 5



אָדָם

Adam - (aw dam) - Man

שֵׁת

Seth - (shayth) - Appointed or substituted or compensated. Comes from the root word שֵׁת (sheeth) which means to put in place.

אנוש

Enosh - From the root word אנוש (en oshe) which means mortal man in its context meaning man in his mortal and weak state of being.

קַיִנָּן

Cainan or Kenan - (Key nan) - To dwell
which comes from the root word קָן -
(kane) - which means nest.

מַהֲלַלֵּי אֵל

Mahalalel - (mah-hal-al-ale') - Combination of two Hebrew words מַהֲלַל meaning to shine or praise. The word אֵל el means God, so Mahalalel means The light of God.

יָרַד

Jared - (yeh'-red) - Descent or brought down or come down.

חֲנוּךְ

**Enoch - (khan-oke) - From the root word
חָנַךְ - (khan-ak) and means to train, to
teach or dedicate to establish a habit.**

**This word is where we get the festival of
Chanukkah.**

**Train up a child in the way he should go,
And when he is old he will not depart
from it.**

PROVERBS 22:6

מֵתוֹשֶׁלַח

Methuselah - (meth-oo-sheh'-lakh) Comes from two words (מוֹת), (maw'-veth) - the word for death. Second part is (שֶׁלַח) shaw-lakh' means sending or bringing forth. The word is in the masculine and means "his death shall bring forth".

לַמֶּכֶךְ

Lamech - (leh'-mek) - Possible

interpretation is that this name is the verb

מוֹךְ (mok, Strong's #4134) meaning

"low" and prefixed by the letter ל

meaning "to" – "to be low."

Noah - (no-akh) - Rest or comfort

דִּין

Strive - (deen) - To contend or plead.

1) Line of Seth – Sons of God are from the descendants of Seth and the daughters of men are of the descendants of Cain. Their union represents the breakdown of the separation of believers and unbelievers. This, however, does not explain why the offspring became Giants. Also nowhere does it say the line of Seth is Godly.

2) Sons of God – bene elohim – this phrase is used only three other times in the bible. All in the book of Job, (1:6; 2:1; 38:7). All references are to Angels.

Now there was a day when the sons of God came to present themselves before the LORD, and Satan also came among them.

JOB 1:6

Again there was a day when the sons of God came to present themselves before the LORD, and Satan came also among them to present himself before the LORD.

JOB 2:1

Sons of God - (bene elohim) - Sons of
God, angels

נְפִילִים

Giants - (naw feel) - Nephilim from the
root word נָפַל (naw fal) Meaning to fall.

שֵׁם

Renown - (shem) - Name or reputation.

**Means they had a name for themselves,
they had a reputation.**

נָחַם

Sorry - (naw-kham') - To repent. In other words it repented the Lord that He had made man on the earth...

"I greatly regret that I have set up Saul as king, for he has turned back from following Me, and has not performed My commandments." And it grieved Samuel, and he cried out to the LORD all night.

I SAMUEL 15:11

And also the Strength of Israel will not lie nor relent. For He is not a man, that He should relent."

I SAMUEL 15:29
