
What is a “parable”? – an earthly story cast alongside a spiritual truth to help the listener understand that specific spiritual truth.

And now, little children, abide in Him,
that when He appears, we may have
confidence and not be ashamed before
Him at His coming.

I JOHN 2:28

IN THIS PARABLE:

- The man going on a journey represents Jesus.
- His going on a journey represents Jesus' ascension.
- The servants represent Christians who are awaiting the Second Coming of Christ
- The talents represent God's resources which God has bestowed on us.
- The man's return represents Jesus' Second Coming.
- The master's assessment of the faithfulness of the servants represents Jesus' judgment of us on Judgment Day.



**Let a man so consider us, as servants
of Christ and stewards of the
mysteries of God.**

I CORINTHIANS 4:1

Moreover it is required in stewards that one be found faithful.

I CORINTHIANS 4:2

ABILITY

Dunamis - power, strength, ability to carry out something

Whatever you do [whatever your task may be], work from the soul [that is, put in your very best effort], as [something done] for the Lord and not for men,

COLOSSIANS 3:23 AMP

Knowing [with all certainty] that it is from the Lord [not from men] that you will receive the inheritance which is your [greatest] reward. It is the Lord Christ whom you [actually] serve.

COLOSSIANS 3:24 AMP

For the Son of Man will come in the
glory of His Father with His angels, and
then He will reward each according to
his works.

MATTHEW 16:27

Just as (not if) each one of you has received a special gift [a spiritual talent, an ability graciously given by God], employ it in serving one another as [is appropriate for] good stewards of God's multi-faceted grace [faithfully using the diverse, varied gifts and abilities granted to Christians by God's unmerited favor].

I PETER 4:10 AMP

Whoever speaks [to the congregation], is to do so as one who speaks the oracles (utterances, the very words) of God. Whoever serves [the congregation] is to do so as one who serves by the strength which God [abundantly] supplies, so that in all things God may be glorified [honored and magnified] through Jesus Christ, to whom belongs the glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen.

I PETER 4:11 AMP

Therefore we make it our aim, whether present or absent, to be well pleasing to Him.

II CORINTHIANS 5:9

GOOD

Meeting a high standard of worth and merit ; disciplined, which measure up to their intended purpose, useful

FAITHFUL

Persons who show themselves faithful in the transaction of business, the execution of commands, or the discharge of official duties

“Now My soul is troubled, and what shall I say? ‘Father, save Me from this hour’? But for this purpose I came to this hour.

JOHN 12:27

Father, glorify Your name.” Then a voice came from heaven, saying, “I have both glorified it and will glorify it again.”

JOHN 12:28

Therefore, my beloved brothers and sisters, be steadfast, immovable, always excelling in the work of the Lord [always doing your best and doing more than is needed], being continually aware that your labor [even to the point of exhaustion] in the Lord is not futile nor wasted [it is never without purpose].

HARD

Skleros - hard, strict, harsh, cruel, merciless, unreasonable)

There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit.

ROMANS 8:1

LAZY

A state involving shrinking from something, holding back, hesitation or reluctance

It carries the idea of a person who has a do-nothing, lethargic, lackadaisical, apathetic, indifferent, lukewarm attitude toward life.

And a servant who knows what the master wants, but isn't prepared and doesn't carry out those instructions, will be severely punished.

LUKE 12:47 NLT

But someone who does not know, and then does something wrong, will be punished only lightly. When someone has been given much, much will be required in return; and when someone has been entrusted with much, even more will be required.

For by grace you are saved through
faith, and this is not from yourselves, it is
the gift of God;

EPHESIANS 2:8 NET

**It is not from works, so that no one
can boast.**

EPHESIANS 2:9 NET

For we are his creative work, having been created in Christ Jesus for good works that God prepared beforehand so we can do them.

EPHESIANS 2:10 NET
