

# GENESIS

Amraphel king of Shinar – Amraphel is a Semitic name, an Amorite name And Shinar as you recall is Babylon where the tower of Babel was built.

Arioch king of Ellasar – Arioch is a Hurrian name

Chedorlaomer king of Elam – This is an Elamite name. Elam was in the area of Persia or Iran today.

Bera - means "son of evil"

בִּרְשָׁע

Birsha king of Gomorrah

Birsha - means "with iniquity"

שִׁנָּב

Shinab king of Admah

Shinab - means "splendor of the father" or possible "sin is Father" according to Fruchtenbaum. Sin being the moon god Sin.

שִׁמְעֵבֶר

Shemeber king of Zeboiim

Shemeber - means "lofty" or "soaring on high."

שִׁדְדִים

Valley of Siddim

Sid-deem means plain or field.
