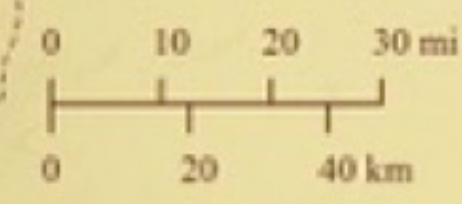
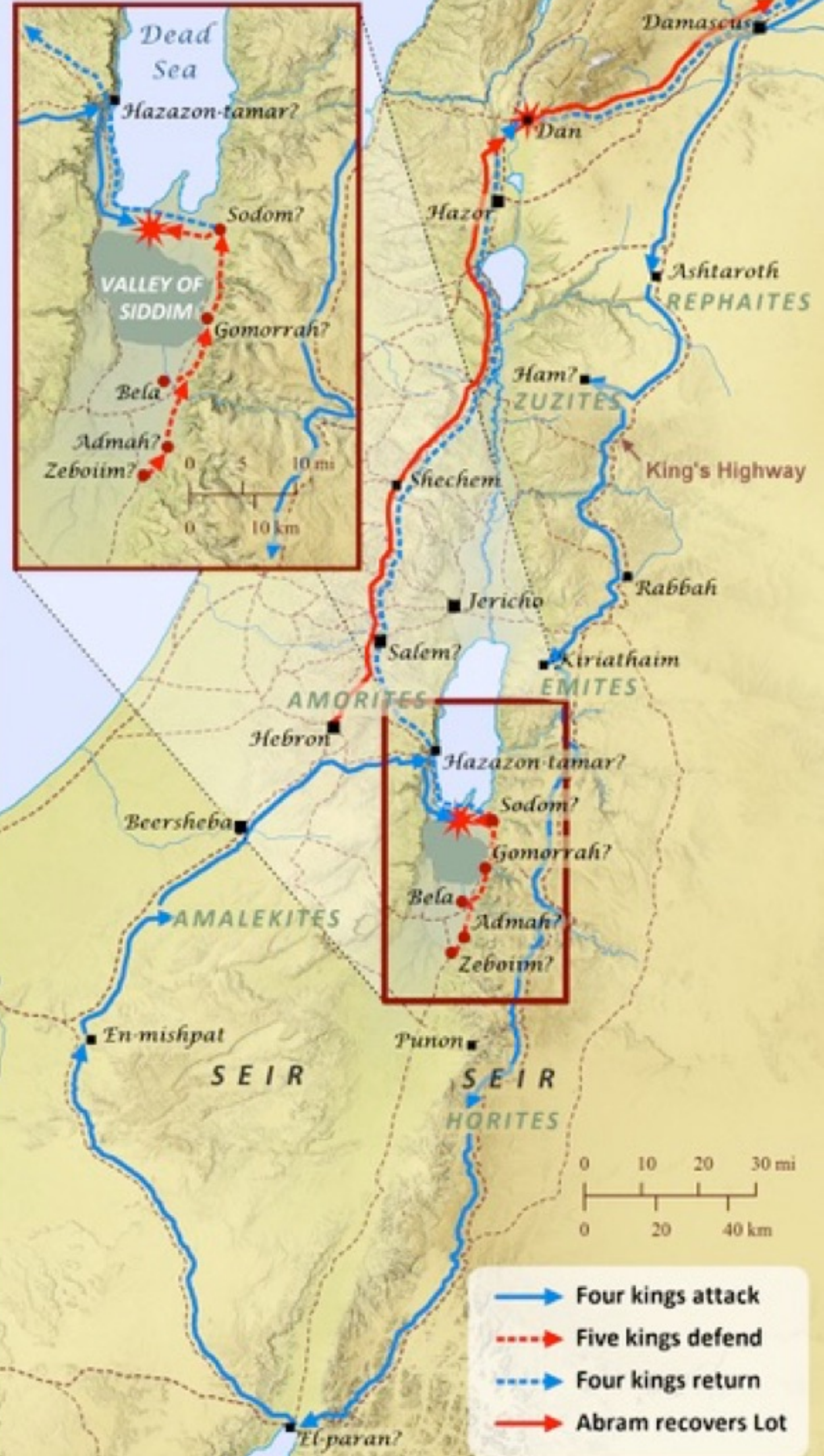


# GENESIS

**King of Sodom gives Abram a business offer**

**King of Salem gives Abram a blessing**

**Dynasty - A dynasty**

**(UK: /'daɪnəsti/, US: /'daɪnəsti/) is a sequence of rulers from the same family.**

**Notice the name.. Melchi – Zedek.**

**2) Superiority is in the form of blessing**

**3) Superiority is Melchizedek's priesthood never ended.**

**4) Superiority is the respect given by Levi to Melchizedek**

- 4) Sacrifice of Giving – 2 Cor.9:6-15; Mark 12:41 - 44**
- 5) Sacrifice of prayer – 1Tim.2:1-3**
