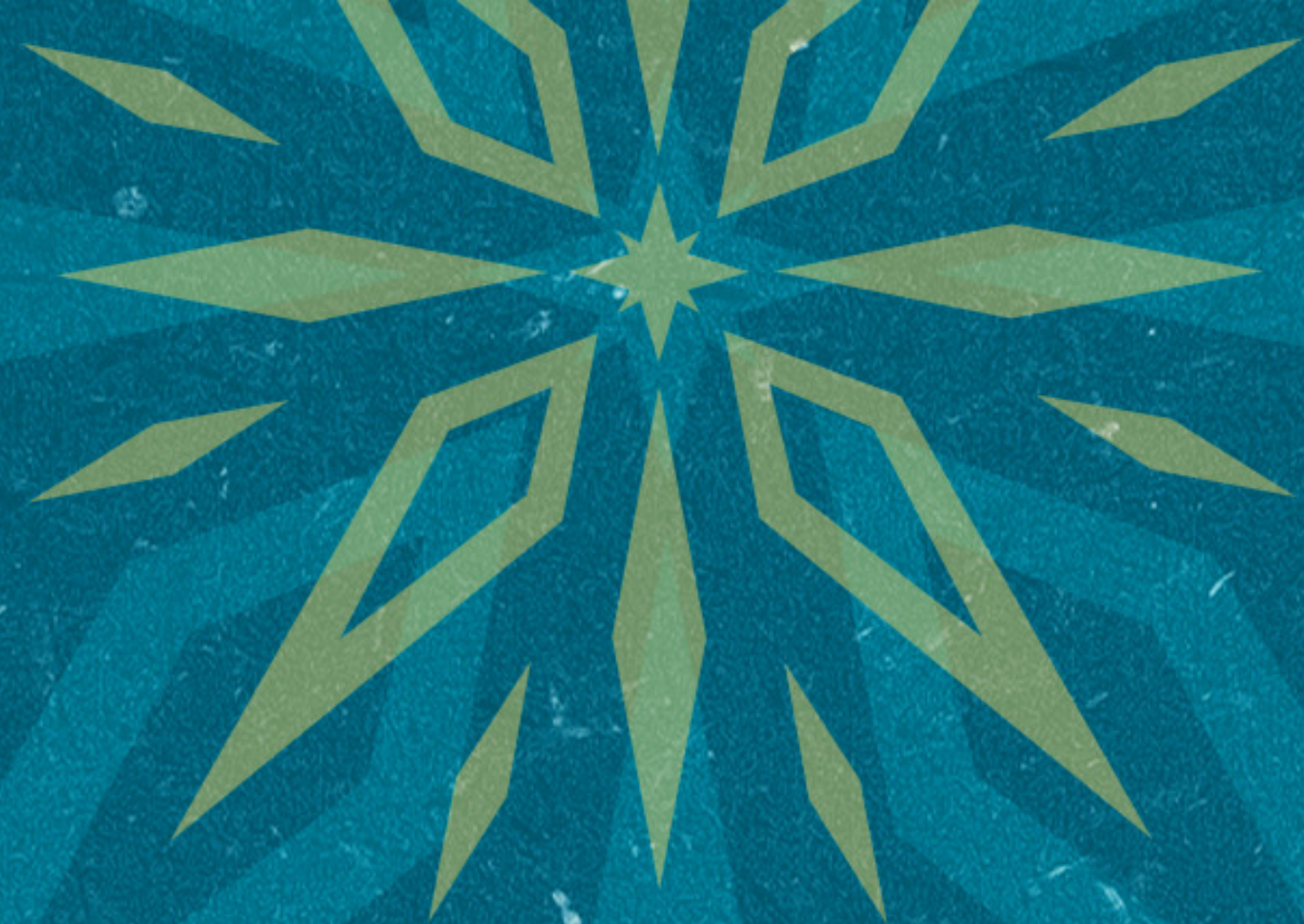

John 8:12 - ...“I am the light of the world. He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but have the light of life.”

John 12:46 - I have come as a light into the world, that whoever believes in Me should not abide in darkness.

He is despised and rejected by men, a
Man of sorrows and acquainted with
grief. And we hid, as it were, our faces
from Him; He was despised, and we did
not esteem Him.

ISAIAH 53:3

**Surely He has borne our griefs and carried
our sorrows; yet we esteemed Him stricken,
smitten by God, and afflicted.**

ISAIAH 53:4

But He was wounded for our transgressions,
He was bruised for our iniquities; the
chastisement for our peace was upon Him,
and by His stripes we are healed.

ISAIAH 53:5

All we like sheep have gone astray; we
have turned, every one, to his own way;
and the LORD has laid on Him the
iniquity of us all.

ISAIAH 53:6

He was oppressed and He was afflicted,
yet He opened not His mouth; He was
led as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a
sheep before its shearers is silent, so He
opened not His mouth.

ISAIAH 53:7

The voice of one crying in the wilderness:
“Prepare the way of the LORD; make straight
in the desert a highway for our God.

ISAIAH 40:3

“Behold, I send My messenger, and he will prepare the way before Me. And the Lord, whom you seek, will suddenly come to His temple, even the Messenger of the covenant, In whom you delight. Behold, He is coming,” says the LORD of hosts.

MALACHI 3:1

Matt. 11:10 - For this is he of whom it is written: "Behold, I send My messenger before Your face, who will prepare Your way before You." (Jesus quotes Malachi)

Matt. 11:11 - "Assuredly, I say to you, among those born of women there has not risen one greater than John the Baptist;...

IESOUS - (EE-AY-SOOCE')

Jesus - of Hebrew origin (H3091); Jesus (i.e. Jehoshua), the name of our Lord and two (three) other Israelites: — Jesus. It is equivalent to Joshua in the Hebrew meaning God is salvation.

HUPSISTOS - (HOOP '-SIS-TOS)

The Highest - superlative from the base of 5311; highest, i.e. (masculine singular) the Supreme (God), or (neuter plural) the heavens: — most high, highest.

Maidservant - It is the feminine form ("doule") of the Greek word "doulos" - a female slave, bondmaid
