The southern sites of Bab edh-Dhra and Numeira are not even remotely visible from the area around Bethel/Ai.

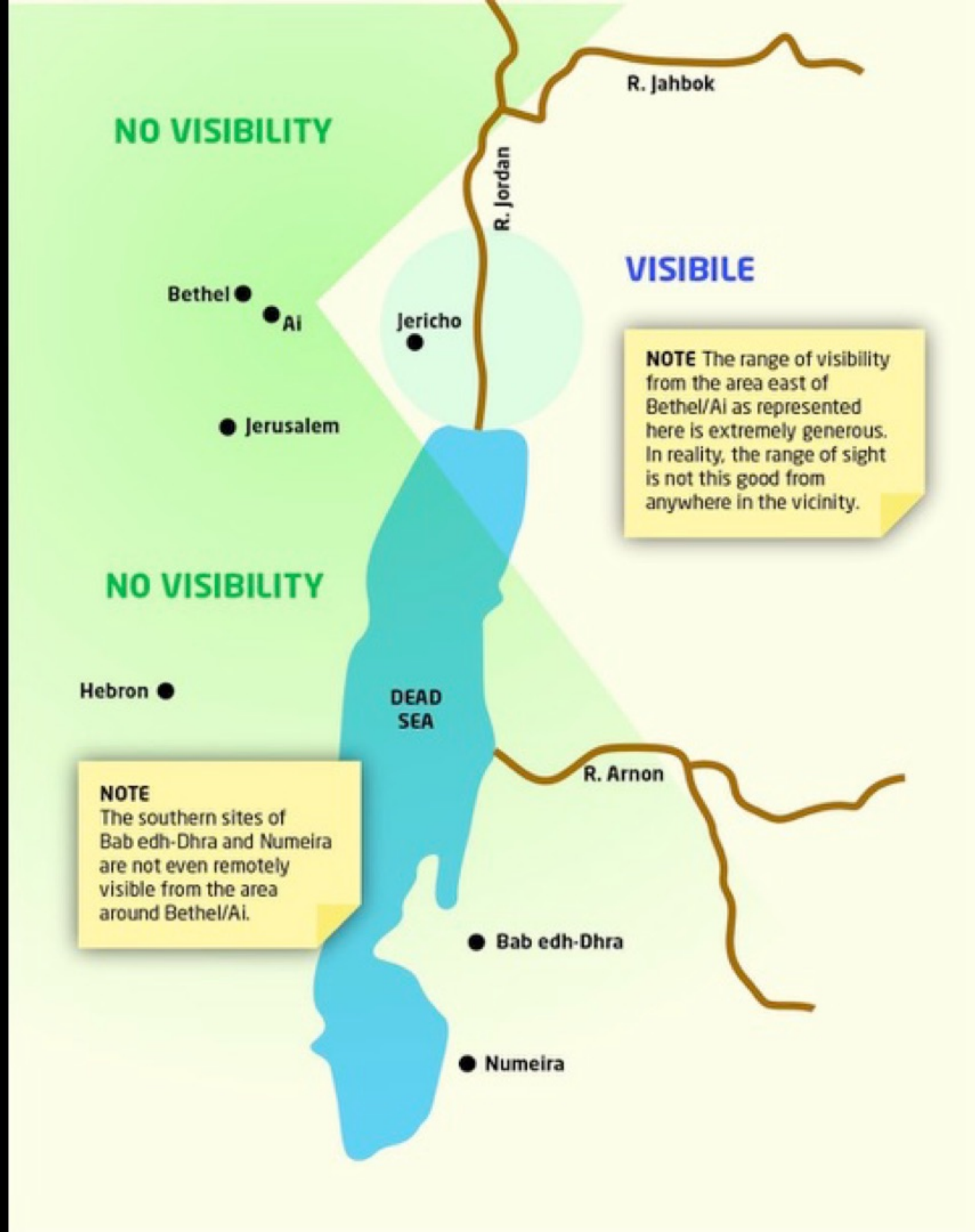

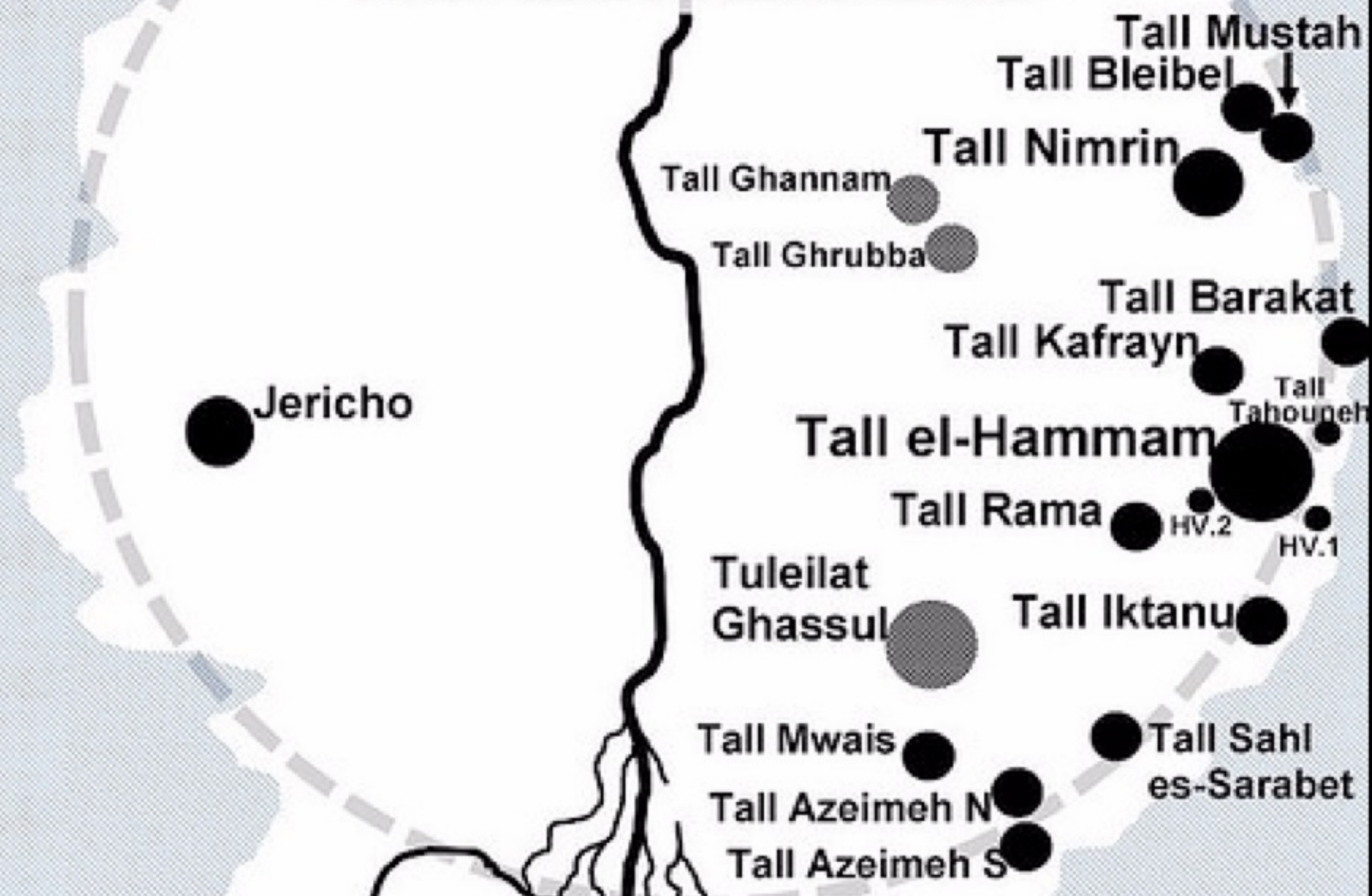
