אל

El - means 'God'

You shall have no other gods before Me.

EXODUS 20:3

“You shall have no other” This phrase is one word in the Hebrew אֲחֵרִים (akh·air') and it is an adjective and it is in the plural. Thus is speaking of false gods.

אֲדֹנָי

Lord (ado-nay, or Adonai) Every time this word is used, it speaks of God.

אֲדֹן

Lord (adon) – always speaks of human lords or masters such kings or master of a servant or even a shepherd over his sheep.

“For the LORD (Yahweh) your God (Elohim) is the God (Elohim) of gods (elohim) and the Lord (Adonay) of lords (adon), the great, the mighty, and the fearsome God (El) who does not show partiality nor take a bribe.

Yahweh - means self existing one, or the

YHWH + vowels of ADONAY =
YAHOWAH (yah-who-wah)

**I AM (hayah, haw-yaw; or EH - YEH) - means
"I will be." In other words God is the one
who is and who will be.**

LORD - Yhwh Yahweh; (the) self-Existent or Eternal; name of God:—the Lord.
