σταυρός

Cross (*stau-ros*) – stake or post used as an instrument for punishment.

For I determined not to know
anything among you except Jesus
Christ and Him crucified.

I CORINTHIANS 2:2

Τετέλεσται

“It is finished” (*Tetelestai*) – *paid in full*

ἀρχή

Principalities (*ar-khay*) – means beginning or originator, the first person or thing in a series, the leader.

ἐξουσία

Powers (*ex-oo-see'-ah*) – means power of authority, the right to exercise power.

ἀπεκδύομαι

Disarmed (*ap-ek-doo'-om-ahee*) - means a separation from what is put off, to strip off for one's self

δειγματίζω

Spectacle (*digh-mat-id'-zo*) - means to make an example of, to show as an example.

παρρησία

Public (*par-rhay-see'-ah*) - openly, frankly, without concealment.

I CORINTHIANS 2:2

ἀρχηγός

Author (*ar-khay-gos*) – Comes from two root words:

ἀρχή

(ar-khay) – means beginning or origin, the first person or thing in a series, the leader

ἄγω

(ag-o) - means to lead with one's self, attach to one's self as an attendant

ἀρχηγός

Author (*ar-khay-gos*) - *means originator
who attends to another*

τελειωτής

Finisher (*telio-tace*) - means *Perfector, to the place of the highest example of Faith. Completer.*

χαρά

Joy (*khar-ah*) – gladness, calm delight.

πρόκειμαι

“Set before Him” (*prok'-i-mahee*) –
destined or appointed.

He shall see the labor of His soul, and be satisfied. By His knowledge My righteous Servant shall justify many, for He shall bear their iniquities.

ISAIAH 53:11

ὑπομένω

Endured (*hoop-om-en'-o*) - *to persevere:
under misfortunes and trials, endurance
under what is burdensome.*

ΚΑΤΑΦΡΟΝΕΩ

Despising (*kat-af-ron-eh'-o*) - *think little or nothing of.*
