Spectacle (digh-mat-id'-zo) - means to make an example of, to show as an example.

## παρρησία

Public (par-rhay-see'-ah) - openly, frankly, without concealment.

### domyós

Author (ar-khay-gos) - means originator who attends to another

### τελειωτής

Finisher (telio-tace) - means Perfector, to the place of the highest example of Faith.
