CRY IS A SEQUENTIAL IMPERFECT VERB WHICH CONNECTS BACK TO RISE

APPLICATION # 2: MAKE A HABIT OF CRYING OUT TO GOD EACH MORNING WHEN YOU WAKE UP.

APPLICATION # 3: WHEN CAN YOU MEDITATE?

VERSES 149-152

LOVINGKINDNESS MEANS THE CONDESCENSION OF GOD TO US

APPLICATION: ARE YOU HUMBLE WHEN YOU PRAY?

WHY IS THE PSALMIST ASKING FOR JUSTICE?

DRAW NEAR MEANS:

YOU ARE NEAR MEANS (PSALM 145:18):

THEY ARE FAR MEANS:

THE PSALMISTS' ENEMIES ARE WICKED AND TEMPORAL. GOD'S WORD IS TRUE AND ETERNAL.

APPLICATION # 5: WHAT FEARS DO YOU NEED TO GET OVER? (PHIL 4:13)

PSALM 119:153-160 RESH STANZA

VERSES 153-154

CONSIDER MEANS:

THE PSALMIST ALSO WANTS DELIVERANCE

APPLICATION # 6: DO YOU BELIEVE THAT ONLY GOD CAN RESCUE YOU?

FORGET MEANS:

THE PSALMIST DOES NOT FORGET THE GUIDANCE FOR HOW TO LIVE FOUND IN GOD'S WORD.

PLEAD MEANS:

REDEEM MEANS:

SUMMARY: THE PSALMIST ASKS GOD TO USE HIS WORD TO REVIVE OR REFRESH HIM IN HIS TIME OF TROUBLE.

VERSES 155-156

THE PSALMISTS' ENEMIES WALK A PATH OF DARKNESS.

APPLICATION # 7: ARE YOU MOVING TOWARD SANCTIFICATION?

SEEK MEANS:

GREAT INCLUDES NUMEROUS MERCIES

GREAT ALSO INCLUDES QUALITY OF MERCIES: RICH AND LAVISH

JUDGMENTS HAVE TO DO WITH DISCERNING RIGHT AND WRONG

SUMMARY: THE PSALMIST ASKS GOD TO REVIVE OR REFRESH HIM BY DISCERNING HIS SITUATION AND VINDICATING HIM.

VERSES 157-159

THE PSALMISTS' ENEMIES ARE REAL PEOPLE (MATT 5:11-12)

APPLICATION # 8: WHEN THINGS GET TOUGH, DO YOU STUBBORNLY DIG INTO THE WORD OF GOD OR DO YOU SET IT ASIDE?

SEE MEANS:

TREACHEROUS MEANS (ROMANS 9:8):

A BETTER TRANSLATION FOR DISGUSTED IS GRIEVED OR SICK AT HEART.

APPLICATION # 9: DO YOU GRIEVE FOR YOUR ENEMIES?

PRECEPTS REFERS TO DETAILS IN THE WORD OF GOD.

SUMMARY: THE PSALMIST ASKS GOD TO REACH DOWN AND REVIVE OR REFRESH HIS LIFE WITH HIS OWN PERSONAL TOUCH OF LOVE.

VERSE 160

ENTIRETY MEANS:

GOD IS BIGGER THAN HIS WORD! (1 COR 13:12)

EVERY JUDGMENT OF GOD HAS ALWAYS BEEN CORRECT.

ISN'T IT COMFORTING TO PERSONALLY KNOW THE ONE TRUE GOD WHO
NEVER MAKES A MISTAKE?
