way. When the Holy Spirit is here, it will be
just as if I am here because We think, behave,

PARACLETES

Helper - comforter...one who comes alongside to assist, "A person who acts as a spokesman or representative of someone's else policy, purpose, or cause. This is who will come along and help the disciples once Jesus ascends to Heaven"

CONFORMED

means to assimilate, sense: to be or become behaviorally or socially similar to; being shaped or molded into a certain pattern

Transformed - to be changed

- This Greek word is where we get our English word...metamorphous (change from within)
- "transformed" in the passive voice means that it happens to you as you submit to it.

Change occurs by the renewing (renewal or renovation) of your mind.

- to cause something to become new and different, with the implication of becoming superior—'to make new' It's renewal through renovation

Heart troubles Part 3 - Philippians 4:6-9

“Think about what you are thinking about”

Philippians 4:6

Be anxious for nothing (stop being anxious – it's already in progress) you're unduly concerned but in everything by prayer & supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God

If you live in the past and you live in the future, you're allowing two thieves to rob your life. But if you live in the present, the Bible says that God is sufficient for every day. In Deuteronomy 33:25b, here's what it says: "As your days, so shall your strength be" meaning God provides the strength you need for today.

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Finally, brethren, whatever things are true, whatever things are noble, whatever things are just, whatever things are pure, whatever things are lovely, whatever things are of good report, if there is any virtue and if there is anything praiseworthy—meditate on these things.

PHILIPPIANS 4:8

This is the list *not to think* about whatever is untrue, ignoble, wrong, impure, unlovely, not admirable, if there is anything shotty or unworthy of praise...do not think about these things!

“Never Abandoned, but Loved and Helped”

But the spiritual man [the spiritually mature Christian] judges all things [questions, examines, and applies what the Holy Spirit reveals], yet is himself judged by no one [the unbeliever cannot judge and understand the believer's spiritual nature].

What are some of Jesus' commandments?

- "If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow me. (Luke 9:23)
- Be anxious for nothing (Philippians 4:6a)
- Do all things without complaining (grumbling) and disputing (arguing) (Philippians 2:14)

Peace – means to join together in a state

ANONYMOUS

Afraid - to lack courage, be cowardly
or fearful

The word "afraid" describes a gripping fear or dread that produces a shrinking back or cowardice. It saps your ability to look at problems head-on and causes you to retreat into self-preservation mode and promotes a lack of courage to face what is before you.

For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.

II TIMOTHY 1:7

“Don’t let your heart be torn up by things that unsettle you, neither let it be taken with fear that causes you to shrink back into cowardice.”

Let this mind be in you which was also in
Christ Jesus,

PHILIPPIANS 2:5

who, being in the form of God, did not
consider it robbery to be equal with
God,

PHILIPPIANS 2:6

but made Himself of no reputation,
taking the form of a bondservant, and
coming in the likeness of men.

PHILIPPIANS 2:7

Robbery - means a thing to be seized upon or to be held fast, retained and has the idea of something being grasped at clung to or a thing held as a prize.

“equality with God” speaks of the glories or prerogatives of God – He gave up His rights
If you put all that together it says... Jesus did not consider equality with God as something to be seized upon or to be held fast, retained, grasped at, clung to or something to be held onto as a prize.
