Basemath (bos-math) – means spice or
fragrance

מַרָּה

Grief (mo-raw) – means trouble, bitterness, sadness of spirit. In other words these women brought trouble to the family. No doubt they did not have the same beliefs and worshipped other gods which brought grief and sadness of spirit to Rebekah.

Lie # 6 "Are you really my son Esau?" He said, 'I am.'" (vs24)

Lie #7 "And he came near and kissed him;" Jacob's kiss is a Lie because Isaac is thinking he is getting a kiss from Esau. (vs27)
