Eliezer – means helper Type of the Holy Spirit.

Unnamed servant – Type of the work of the Holy Spirit sent to gather the bride for the Son.

Sarah – Type of Israel

Rebekah – Type that represents the Church, the bride of Christ

Put (soom) – means to place or set

Ladder (sool-lawm) – a stair case.

For it pleased the Father that in Him all
