Journey (reh gel) – means feet. His journey  
would be on foot.

**Relative (awhk) – means brother. Brother of same parents or half brother or relative or kinsman of the same tribe.**

לֵאָה

Leah (le-a) – means wild cow or wearied or weak

רַחֵל

Rachel (raw-chel) – means ewe as in a baby lamb

רַדָּה

Delicate (ra-ak) – means tender or weak

## **4 ways Jacob reaps what he sows:**

**1) First it is during the evening when it is dark and Jacob could not see very well that Jacob is deceived just like Isaac's blindness kept him from seeing very well when he was deceived.**

**2) Second, we see a reversal of sorts. Jacob is deceived by being presented the older for the younger. For Isaac it was the younger being presented as the older.**

**4 ways Jacob reaps what he sows:**

**3) Third Jacob thought Leah was Rachel and Isaac thought Jacob was Esau.**

**4) Fourth, Jacob pretended to be Esau the older brother and Leah pretended to be Rachel the younger sister.**

**זִלְפָּה**

**Zilpah (zil paw) – means a trickling, or a fragrant drop. She is a maid servant of Leah's.**

**1) Pharaoh, king of Egypt, Gave orders for every son of the Hebrews to be drowned in Ex.1:22.....then in Ex.14:28 – Pharaoh and all his army is drowned.**

**2) Korah – caused division in the congregation of Israel. Num.16:2-3 ...Then God caused a division in the earth and swallowed him up. Num.16:30.**

**3) Adoni Bezek – Cut off the thumbs and toes of 70 kings Judges 1:5-7 then his thumbs and toes were cut off Judges 1:7**

**4) King Ahab – Wicked Ahab caused Naboth to be killed and dogs came and licked up his blood. 1 Kings 21:19. Then when Ahab was killed and died in his chariot, the dogs came and licked up his blood. 1 Kings 22:38**

**5) Haman – wicked Haman in the book of Esther built gallows to hang that righteous Jew Mordecai, only to be hanged on those very same Gallows himself while Mordecai was vindicated. (Esther 7:9-10)**

**6) Paul – when he was Saul, stood by and consented to the stoning of the first Christian martyr Stephen as they dragged Stephen outside the city and stoned him. Acts 7:57-58.**

**Later when Paul was in Lystra he also was dragged outside the city and was stoned and was left for dead although he survived. (Acts 14:19)**
