God (el-o-heem) – Gods. It's the plural form of the singular God.

גָּלָה

Appeared (gaw-law) – to uncover or reveal, or make known, to appear....it's a verb and it is in the plural form.

יָנָק

Nurse (yaw-nak) – means to suckle, a nursing woman. Thus Deborah was a nurse maid and would have helped out with the nursing and raising of Jacob and Esau.

אַלּוֹן בַּכּוּת

Allon Bacuth (a-lone-baw-cooth) – means  
“Oak of weeping”.

Declared (ex-ay-geh-oh-my) - means to unfold, to tell, to declare, to make known.

מַצֵּבָה

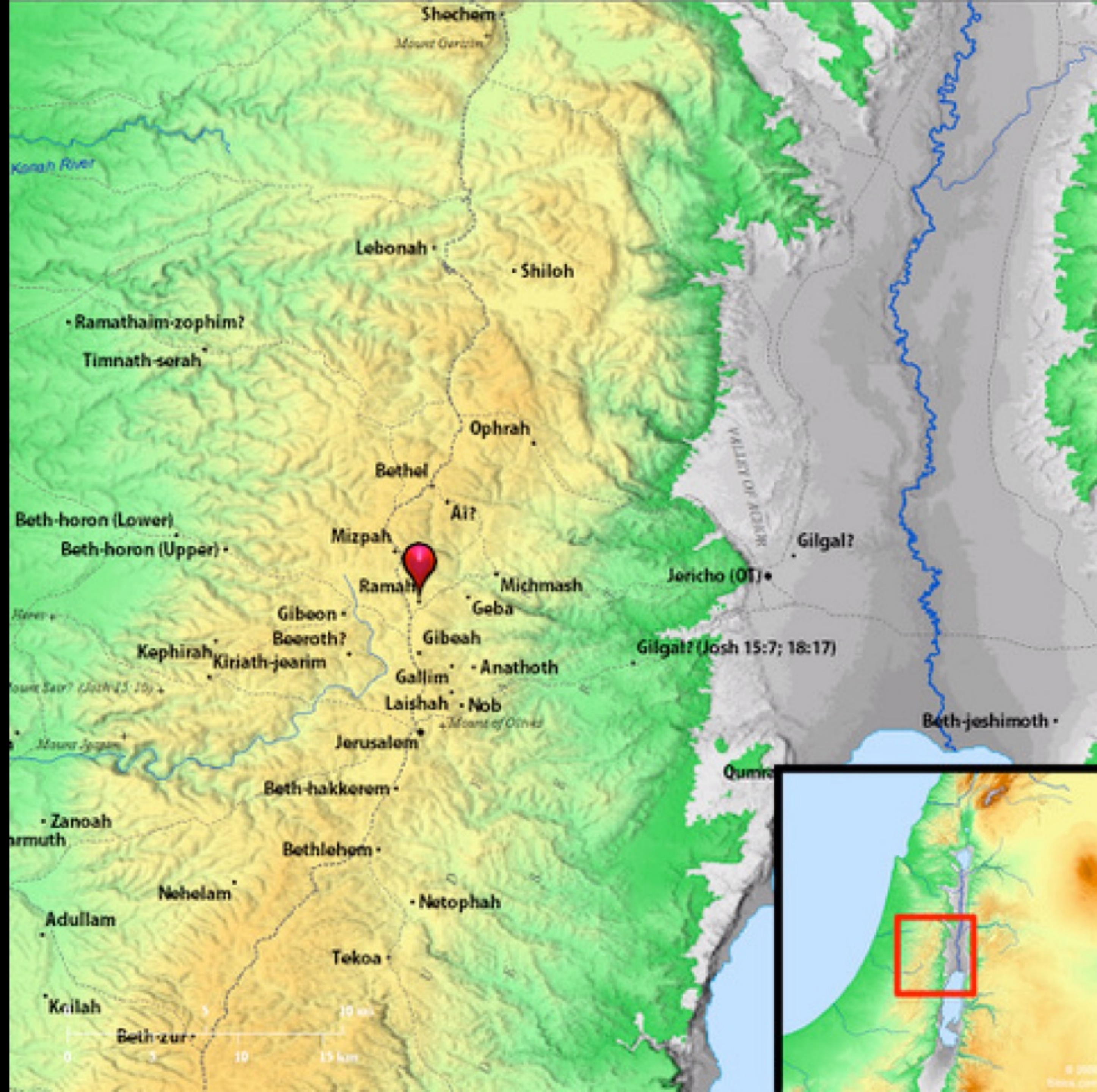
When you have departed from me today, you will find two men by Rachel's tomb in the territory of Benjamin at Zelzah;...
