In Padan Aram – Hebrew - אֶרֶם פִּדְוֹן

Well the problem seems to stem from the preposition “In” it is the Hebrew letter אָ

According to BDB – Brown- Driver –
Briggs Lexicon The Hebrew

letter א here in this text could mean “in”
or it could mean “through” or it could
mean “by means of” or “on account of”

GENESIS 49:31

When Esau was forty years old, he took as wives Judith the daughter of Beerli the Hittite, and Basemath the daughter of Elon the Hittite.

GENESIS 26:34

So Esau went to Ishmael and took Mahalath the daughter of Ishmael, Abraham's son, the sister of Nebajoth, to be his wife in addition to the wives he had.

GENESIS 28:9

- **Judith = Oholibamah**
- **Basemath = Adah**
- **Mahalath = Basemath**

יְהוּדִית

Judith (jeh-ho-deeth) –
means praise. It's the feminine form of Judah.

אֹהֶל־בָּמָה

Oholibamah (o-hol-lee-baw-maw) – tent of
high place

בַּשְׂמַת

Basemath (bos-math) – means spice or fragrance.

עֲדָה

Adah (aw-daw) – means ornament.

מַחֲלָת

Mahalath (maw-cha-let) - means stringed instrument.

בַּשְּׂמַת

Basemath (bos-math) – means spice or fragrance.

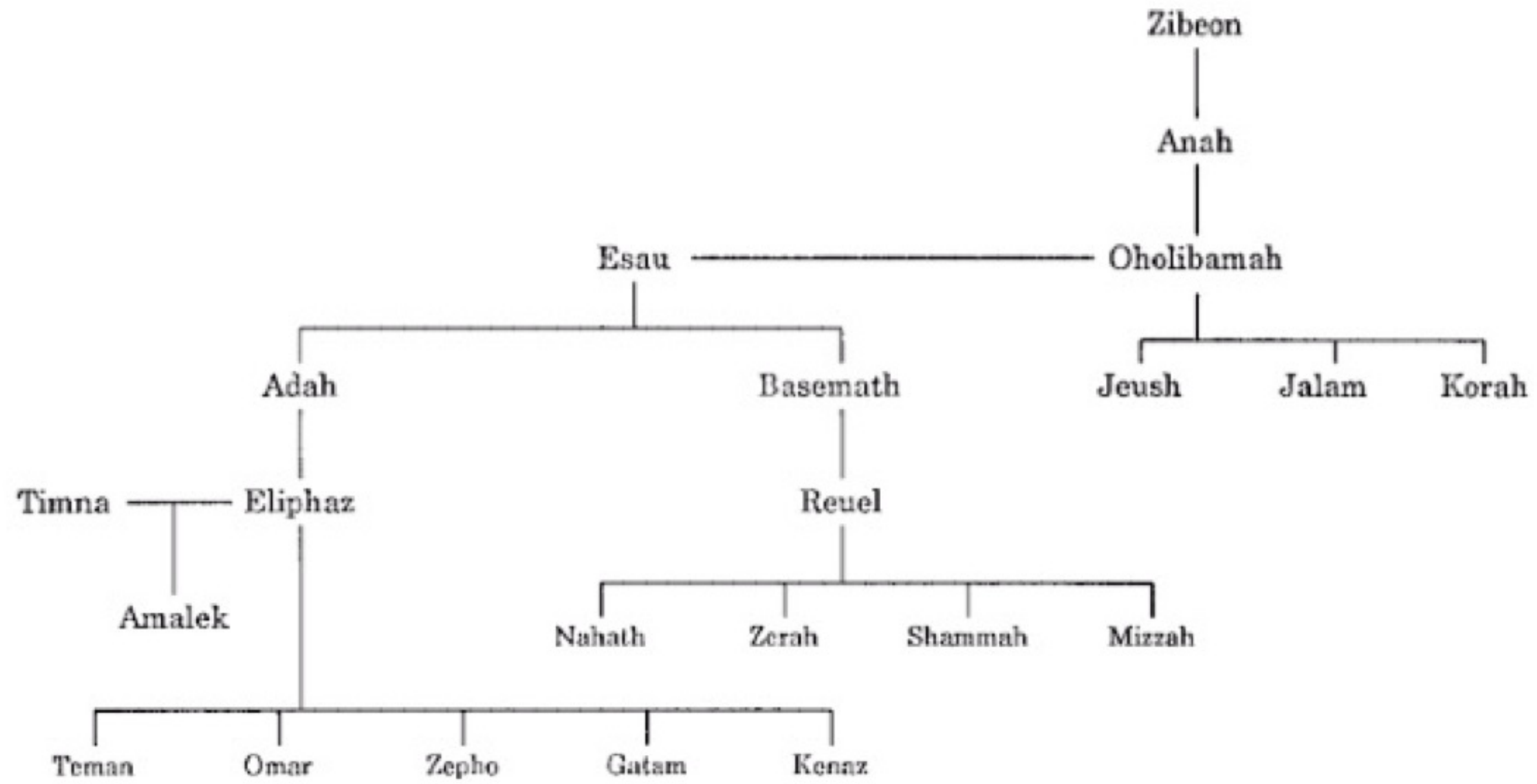
אֶדוֹם

GENESIS 27:40

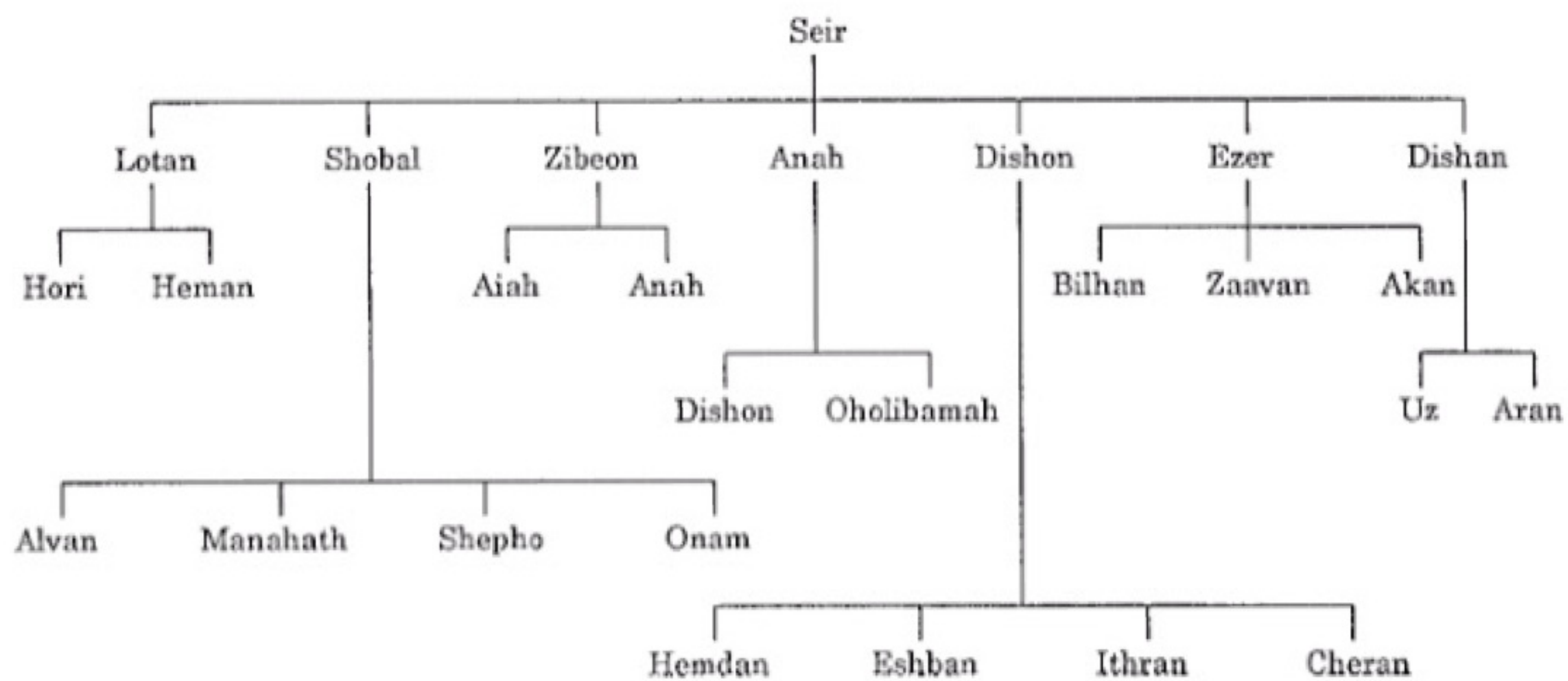
חֲרִי
