

Christophany - comes from two Greek words; Christos, which means Christ, and phaneroo, which means to be revealed or to manifest. Therefore, a Christophany is a visible manifestation or appearance of Christ before taking on human form through the virgin birth.

Bush – Hebrew word - קְּנֶה sen-eh'; from an unused root meaning to prick; a bramble: — bush. So this was a thorn bush.

Then to Adam He said, "Because you have heeded the voice of your wife, and have eaten from the tree of which I commanded you, saying, 'You shall not eat of it': "Cursed is the ground for your sake; In toil you shall eat of it All the days of your life.

Both thorns and thistles it shall bring forth for you,

And you shall eat the herb of the field.

But concerning the resurrection of the dead, have you not read what was spoken to you by God, saying,

Honey – Hebrew word – דְּבַשׁ – dev ash – means honey or syrup. This could mean honey from both Bees and from fruit such as Date Honey.

I will be – is one word in the Hebrew – קיה – haw yaw – means to be, become, come to pass.

Certainly – Hebrew word -בי – Kee – means because or surely.

קּיָה AM WHO I AM – Hebrew words - אֲשָׁר הְיָה - Haya Asher Haya – or or Eh Yeh asher Eh Yeh meaning "I AM Who I AM" or "I AM THAT I AM"

'Now see that I, even I, am He, And there is no God besides Me; I kill and I make alive; I wound and I heal; Nor is there any who can deliver from My hand.

I am He – Greek words - ἐγώ εἰμί - ego eimi

Therefore My people shall know My name; Therefore they shall know in that day That I am He who speaks: 'Behold, it is I.'" But He said to them, "It is I; (ego eimi) do not be afraid."

Fell – Greek word **πίπτω** – pipto – means to be thrust down, to fall prostrate. They are face down before the great I AM.

LORD – Hebrew word – יהוה – Yhwh yod hey waw hey Yahweh; (the) self-Existent one or Eternal one; name of God: —the LORD.

Memorial – Hebrew word – אַבֶּר – zay ker - means remembrance, memory In other words this is how God wants his name to be remembered, YHWH.

And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living being.

Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name,

that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
