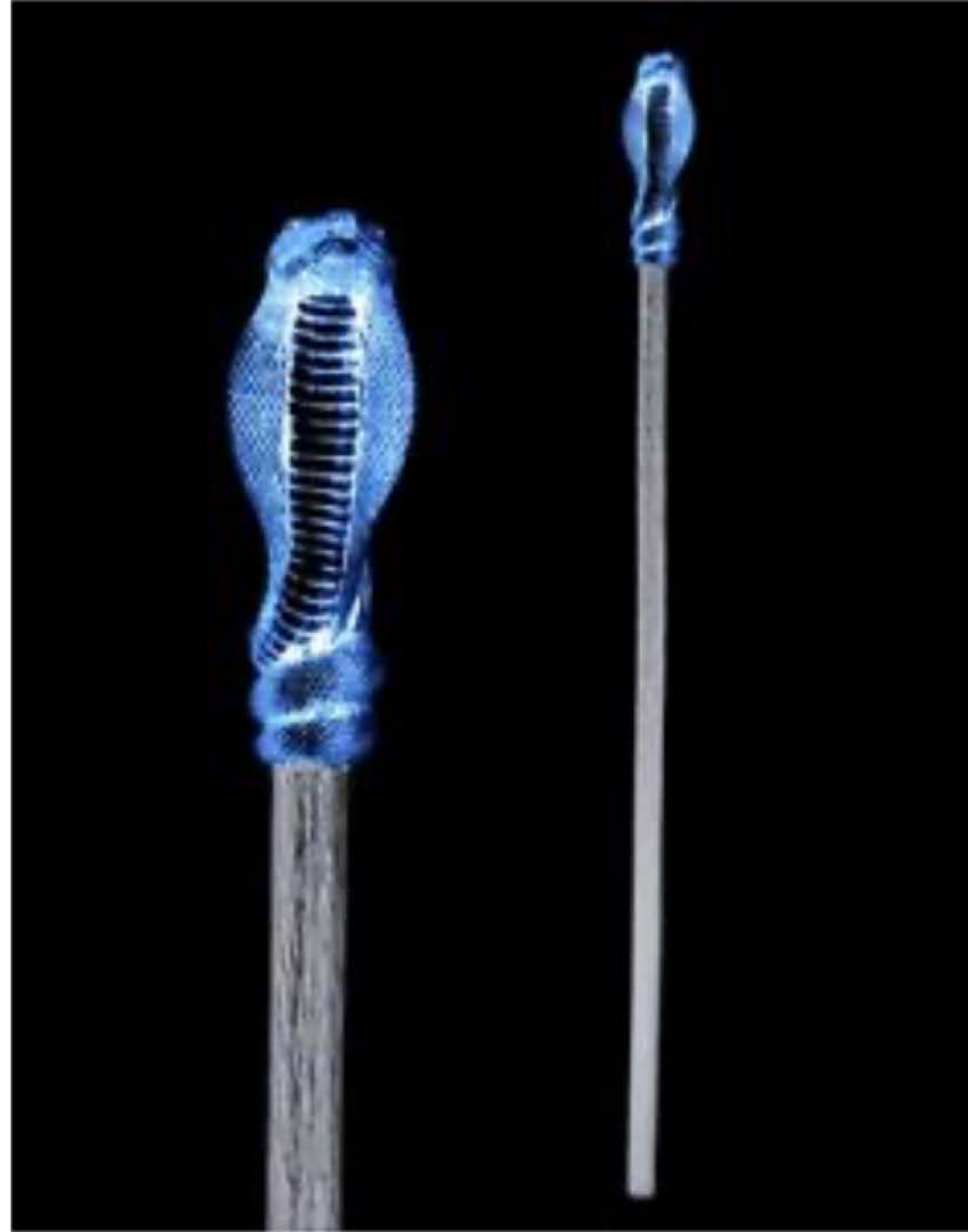
## The 5 Objections:

1. Vs 3:11 I am not adequate - who Am I
2. Vs 3:13 Who do I say sent me - who are You
3. Vs 4:1 What if they won't believe me
4. Vs 4:10 I am not a good speaker
5. Vs 4:13 Please send someone else

God gives Moses 3 signs

- 1) Rod or staff
- 2) Leprous hand
- 3) Turning water into blood

**rod** – Hebrew word – מַטֵּה (mat the) means  
staff, rod or shaft





“For his letters,” they say, “are weighty and powerful, but his bodily presence is weak, and his speech contemptible.”

II CORINTHIANS 10:10

Even though I am untrained in speech, yet I am not in knowledge. But we have been thoroughly manifested among you in all things.

II CORINTHIANS 11:6

And I, brethren, when I came to you, did not come with excellence of speech or of wisdom declaring to you the testimony of God.

1 CORINTHIANS 2:1

For I determined not to know anything among you except Jesus Christ and Him crucified. I was with you in weakness, in fear, and in much trembling.

1 CORINTHIANS 2:2-3

And my speech and my preaching were not with persuasive words of human wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power,

I CORINTHIANS 2:4

that your faith should not be in the wisdom  
of men but in the power of God.

1 CORINTHIANS 2:5

**make** – Hebrew word – שׁוּם (soom)  
means to put, to place, to set, to appoint,  
to direct, to make.

For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the Lord, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope.

**JEREMIAH 29:11**

Then you will call upon Me and go and pray to Me, and I will listen to you. And you will seek Me and find Me, when you search for Me with all your heart.

**JEREMIAH 29:12-13**

Now when Herod was dead, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared in a dream to Joseph in Egypt,

**MATTHEW 2:19**

saying, “Arise, take the young Child and His mother, and go to the land of Israel, for those who sought the young Child’s life are dead.”

**MATTHEW 2:20**

Then he arose, took the young Child and His mother, and came into the land of Israel.

**MATTHEW 2:21**

For Jews request a sign, and Greeks seek after wisdom, but we preach Christ crucified, to the Jews a stumbling block and to the Greeks foolishness,

**I CORINTHIANS 1:22-23**

but to those who are called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God and the wisdom of God.

I CORINTHIANS 1:24

And Jethro, the priest of Midian, Moses' father-in-law, heard of all that God had done for Moses and for Israel His people—that the Lord had brought Israel out of Egypt.

EXODUS 18:1

Then Jethro, Moses' father-in-law, took Zipporah, Moses' wife, after he had sent her back...

EXODUS 18:2

“Do not think that I came to destroy the Law or the Prophets. I did not come to destroy but to fulfill.

**MATTHEW 5:17**

For assuredly, I say to you, till heaven and earth pass away, one jot or one tittle will by no means pass from the law till all is fulfilled.

**MATTHEW 5:18**

Whoever therefore breaks one of the least of these commandments, and teaches men so, shall be called least in the kingdom of heaven; but whoever does and teaches them, he shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven.

**MATTHEW 5:19**



for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus,

ROMANS 3:23-24

whom God set forth as a propitiation by His blood, through faith, to demonstrate His righteousness, because in His forbearance God had passed over the sins that were previously committed,
