

EXODUS

This narrative is broken down into 8 events

- 1) Moses and Aaron before Pharaoh 5:1-5
- 2) Pharaoh's instruction to the taskmasters 5:6-9
- 3) Taskmasters treatment of the Israelite foremen 5:10-14
- 4) Israelite foremen petition Pharaoh 5:15-18
- 5) Israelite foremen confront Moses & Aaron 5:19-21
- 6) Moses questions YHWH 5:22- 6:8
- 7) Moses speaks to the Israelites 6:9
- 8) YHWH speaks with Moses 6:10-21

Then they will heed your voice; and you shall come, you and the **elders of Israel**, to the king of Egypt; and you shall say to him,

EXODUS 3:18

...“The LORD God of the Hebrews has met with us; and now, please, let us go three days’ journey into the wilderness, that we may sacrifice to the LORD our God.’

EXODUS 3:18

Afterward Moses and Aaron went in and told Pharaoh, “Thus says the LORD God of Israel: ‘Let My people go, that they may hold a feast to Me in the wilderness.’ ”

EXODUS 5:1

...“The LORD God of the Hebrews has met with us; and now, please, let us go three days’ journey into the wilderness, that we may sacrifice to the LORD our God.’

EXODUS 3:18

Thus says the LORD: “By this you shall know that I *am* (YHWH) LORD. Behold, I will strike the waters which are in the river with the rod that is in my hand, and they shall be turned to blood.

EXODUS 7:17

And in that day I will set apart the land of Goshen, in which My people dwell, that no swarms of flies shall be there, in order that you (Pharaoh) may know that I *am* (YHWH) LORD in the midst of the land.

EXODUS 8:22

Every word of God is pure;
He is a shield to those who put their trust in
Him.

PROVERBS 30:5

Do not add to His words, Lest He rebuke you, and you be found a liar.

PROVERBS 30:6

Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were uneducated and untrained men, they marveled. And they realized that they had been with Jesus.

ACTS 4:13

Truly, these times of ignorance God overlooked, but now commands all men everywhere to repent,

ACTS 17:30

And this is His commandment: that we should believe on the name of His Son Jesus Christ and love one another, as He gave us commandment.

I JOHN 3:23

...the Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven
with His mighty angels,

II THESSALONIANS 1:7

in flaming fire taking vengeance on those
who do not know God, and on those who
do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus
Christ.

II THESSALONIANS 1:8

God *is* faithful, by whom you were called into the fellowship of His Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.

I CORINTHIANS 1:9

But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name:

JOHN 1:12

Taskmaster – Hebrew word – נָגֵשׁ – naw
gas – means to press, to drive to laborious
work, oppressor, slave driver, tyrant.

Officers – Hebrew word – שָׂטָר – sa tare –
means official or scribe

Jesus said to him, “You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.’

MATTHEW 22:37

This is the first and great commandment.

MATTHEW 22:38

And the second is like it: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.'

MATTHEW 22:39

On these two commandments hang all the Law and the Prophets.”

MATTHEW 22:40

Stubble – Hebrew word – קַשׁ – kas – means chaff. Outer husks of stalks.

Straw – Hebrew word – תֵּבַן – te ben – means stalks of grain chopped up and used for fodder for animals or for building materials such as brick.

Beaten – Hebrew word – נָכָה – na kah –
means to strike.

Servant - Hebrew word – עֶבֶד – e ved –
from the root word – עָבַד – aw vad –
means to serve, to work, to be subject to,
to worship.
