<sup>44</sup>Now His betrayer had given them a signal, saying, "Whomever I kiss, He is the One; seize Him and lead Him away safely."

<sup>45</sup>As soon as he had come, immediately he went up to Him and said to Him, "Rabbi, Rabbi!" and kissed Him.

Vs 44 - Kiss here is the Greek wd -  $\phi\iota\lambda\dot{\epsilon}\omega$  fil eh o meaning a kiss of a friend, a one time kiss on the cheek. But when he came forward and kissed Jesus the word is different in verse 45.

Vs 45 - Kiss Greek wd - καταφιλέω kat afee-leh'-o means to kiss again and again.

Fell – Greek word  $\pi i \pi \tau \omega$  – pipto – means to be thrust down, to fall prostrate. They are face down before the great I AM.

Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. But Jesus said to him, "Put your sword in its place, for all who take the sword will perish by the sword. Or do you think that I cannot now pray to My Father, and He will provide Me with more than twelve legions of angels?
