MARK 14:45

Vs 44 - Kiss here is the Greek wd - φιλέω
fil eh o meaning a kiss of a friend, a one
time kiss on the cheek. But when he came
forward and kissed Jesus the word is
different in verse 45.

Vs 45 - Kiss Greek wd - καταφιλέω kat af-
ee-leh'-o means to kiss again and again.

Fell – Greek word πίπτω – pipto – means to be thrust down, to fall prostrate. They are face down before the great I AM.

Therefore God also has highly exalted
Him and given Him the name which is
above every name,

that at the name of Jesus every knee
should bow, of those in heaven, and
of those on earth, and of those under
the earth,

and that every tongue should confess
that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory
of God the Father.
