

"You stiff-necked and uncircumcised in heart and ears! You always resist the Holy Spirit; as your fathers did, so do you.

Which of the prophets did your fathers not persecute? And they killed those who foretold the coming of the Just One, of whom you now have become the betrayers and murderers,

Lord why have YOU brought trouble to this people? Why is it YOU have sent me? ... neither have YOU delivered Your people....

Here we see the 7 "I Wills" of Redemption:

- 1) I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians.
- 2) I will rescue you from their bondage
- 3) I will redeem you with an outstretched arm and with great judgments.
- 4) I will take you as My people.
- 5) I will be your God.
- 6) I will bring you into the land.
- 7) I will give it to you as a heritage.

Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.

Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.

For My yoke is easy and My burden is light."

Then Jesus said to those Jews who believed Him, "If you abide in My word, you are My disciples indeed.

And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free."

They answered Him, "We are Abraham's descendants, and have never been in bondage to anyone. How can You say, 'You will be made free'?"

Jesus answered them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, whoever commits sin is a slave of sin.

And a slave does not abide in the house forever, but a son abides forever.

Therefore if the Son makes you free, you shall be free indeed.

For you were bought at a price; therefore glorify God in your body and in your spirit, which are God's.

knowing that you were not redeemed with corruptible things, like silver or gold, from your aimless conduct received by tradition from your fathers, but with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot. But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name:

But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light;

who once were not a people but are now the people of God, who had not obtained mercy but now have obtained mercy. And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

And what agreement has the temple of God with idols? For you are the temple of the living God. As God has said: "I will dwell in them And walk among them. I will be their God, And they shall be My people."

"Let not your heart be troubled; you believe in God, believe also in Me. In My Father's house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also.

And where I go you know, and the way you know."

In Him you also trusted, after you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation; in whom also, having believed, you were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise,

who is the guarantee of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, to the praise of His glory. Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His abundant mercy has begotten us again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, to an inheritance incorruptible and undefiled and that does not fade away, reserved in heaven for you, who are kept by the power of God through faith for salvation ready to be revealed in the last time. Amram – Hebrew word – עַמְרָם – am ram – means exalted people.

Jochebed – Hebrew word – יוֹכֶבֶד – yoke eved – means YHWH is Glory.

Aaron – Hebrew word – אַהֲרוֹן – aha rone - means light bringer.

Moses – Hebrew word – מֹשֶׁה – Moshe – means drawn out.

Elisheba – Hebrew wordd – אֱלִישֶׁבַע – el lee sheh vah – means God is an oath by which one swears or the oath of God. Then the word of the LORD came to me, saying:

"Before I formed you in the womb I knew you; Before you were born I sanctified you; I ordained you a prophet to the nations."
