

EXODUS

So I will stretch out My hand and strike Egypt with all My **wonders** which I will do in its midst; and after that he will let you go.

EXODUS 3:20

Wonders – Hebrew word – פלא – paw law
– means Extraordinary, marvelous, to
separate, to distinguish. In other words to
show yourself distinct and separate by
doing extraordinary and marvelous things.

And I will harden Pharaoh's heart, and multiply My signs and My wonders in the land of Egypt.

EXODUS 7:3

Sign – Hebrew word – **אוֹת** – ot – means sign or signal. A sign or a signal tells you something.

But Pharaoh will not heed you, so that I may lay My hand on Egypt and bring My armies and My people, the children of Israel, out of the land of Egypt by great judgments. *(also Ex.6:6b)*

EXODUS 7:4

Judgments – Hebrew word – שִׁפְטָה – she
phet – means punishment or sentence.

And the LORD said to Moses, “I will bring one more plague on Pharaoh and on Egypt...

EXODUS 11:1

Plague – Hebrew word – נִגַּע – neh gah
means a blow, to strike, to be stricken

Swallowed – Hebrew word - **בָּלַע** – baw
laa – means to destroy, to devour. Same
word used in the Song of Moses to
describe the Egyptians being destroyed,
swallowed up at the Red Sea in Exodus
15:12.

Serpent in Ex.4:3 is the Hebrew word -
נָחָשׁ - naw-hawsh means snake or
serpent.

Serpent in Ex.7:9,10,12 is the Hebrew
word – תַּנִּינִן – tan neen – means
marine or land monster, dragon, sea
monster, serpent or whale.

“Son of man, set your face against Pharaoh king of Egypt, and prophesy against him, and against all Egypt.

EZEKIEL 29:2

Speak, and say, 'Thus says the Lord GOD:
"Behold, I am against you,
O Pharaoh king of Egypt,
O great monster who lies in the midst of his
rivers,
Who has said, 'My River is my own;
I have made it for myself.'

EZEKIEL 29:3

Their wine is the poison of serpents,
And the cruel venom of cobras.

DEUTERONOMY 32:33

Cobra is the Hebrew word- פֶּתֶן – pe ten – means venomous snake such as an asp, adder, cobra.

Miracle -is the Hebrew word – **מוֹפֵת** – mo
faith – meaning a sign, or wonderful display
of God's power.

Enchantments – Hebrew word - **לְהַט** – la
hat - means blaze, flaming sword,
enwrapped, covert, secret, covered up.
Theirs was a trick, a sleight of hand.
