Humble - עֲנָה (aw naw) Hebrew word
that means to bow down. *How long will
you refuse to bow down before Me?*

“God resists the proud, but gives grace to the humble.” Therefore humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you in due time, casting all your care upon Him, for He cares for you.

Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord,

Snare - מִקְשׁ (mo kaysh) Hebrew word that means noose, or hook or trap. In other words, *How long will this man trap us to our own destruction?*

Evil - רָע (*ra*) Hebrew word that means wicked evil, bad.

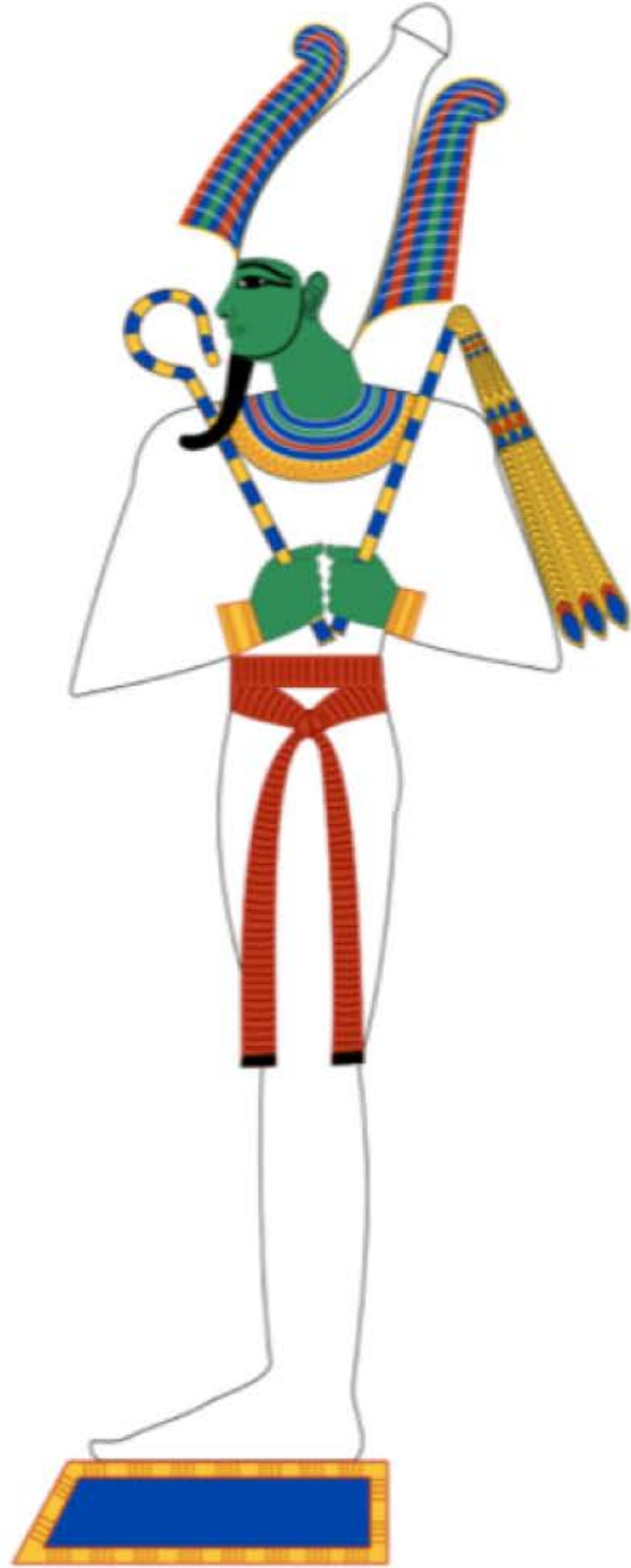
“But as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.”

Darkness - חֹשֶׁךְ (kho shek) Hebrew word means the dark, obscurity, misery, destruction, death.

Felt - מַשֵּׁשׁ (*maw shash*) Hebrew word,
means to grope, to feel.
