שעל – ba al is the Canaanite and Phoenician deity.


אָפּוֹן – sephon – means north or northward or north quarter.



Bewildered – Hebrew word – ☐ — buk means entangled.















"This monument is erected by King Solomon, king of Israel, in honor of Yahweh in commemoration of the crossing of the Red Sea."
