4 stanzas:

Vs 1-5 – God's victory is announced

Vs 6-10 – God's power is described

Vs 11-16 – God's character is exalted

Vs 16-18 – God's promises are fulfilled

Exalt – Hebrew word – **רום** – room – means to lift up, to raise up, to be lofty, to set up high.

⁸I am the **LORD, that *is* My name;**
And My glory I will not give to another,
Nor My praise to carved images.

Commander Hebrew word – שַׂר sare – means prince, captain, ruler

Army – Hebrew word – צָבָא sava – means host or army.

¹¹He even exalted himself as high as the Prince of the host; and by him the daily sacrifices were taken away, and the place of His sanctuary was cast down.

DANIEL 8:11

⁴¹The Son of Man will send out His angels,
and they will gather out of His kingdom all

basiloose – means Commander, Prince
thus Prince of princes.

²³Therefore Michal the daughter of Saul had no children to the day of her death.
