

## 4 stanzas:

Vs 1-5 – God's victory is announced

Vs 6-10 – God's power is described

Vs 11-16 –God's character is exalted

Vs 16-18 – God's promises are fulfilled

<sup>13</sup>I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.

**Exalt** – Hebrew wordd – Din – room – means to lift up, to raise up, to be lofty, to set up high.

<sup>8</sup>I am the LORD, that is My name; And My glory I will not give to another, Nor My praise to carved images. <sup>21</sup> Therefore behold, I will this once cause them to know, I will cause them to know My hand and My might; And they shall know that My name is the LORD. (YHWH)

<sup>6</sup>Yet I have chosen Jerusalem, that My name may be there...

## YHWH – יהוָה Yod Hey Waw Hey.





<sup>13</sup>The LORD shall go forth like a mighty man; He shall stir up His zeal like a man of war. He shall cry out, yes, shout aloud; He shall prevail against His enemies.

<sup>28</sup>Therefore take heed to yourselves and to all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the church of God which He purchased with His own blood.

<sup>23</sup>Then He inaugurated Joshua the son of Nun, and said, "Be strong and of good courage; for you shall bring the children of Israel into the land of which I swore to them, and I will be with you."

<sup>10</sup>And I fell at his feet to worship him. But he said to me, "**See that you do** not **do that!** I am your fellow servant, and of your brethren who have the testimony of Jesus. Worship God...

<sup>8</sup>Now I, John, saw and heard these things. And when I heard and saw, I fell down to worship before the feet of the angel who showed me these things. Then he said to me, "See that you do not do that. For I am your fellow servant, and of your brethren the prophets, and of those who keep the words of this book. Worship God."

<sup>14</sup>But when the apostles Barnabas and Paul heard this, they tore their clothes and ran in among the multitude, crying out <sup>15</sup> and saying, "Men, why are you doing these things? We also are men with the same nature as you, and preach to you that you should turn from these useless things to the living God, who made the heaven, the earth, the sea, and all things that are in them,

Commander Hebrew word – שור sare – means prince, captain, ruler

Army – Hebrew word – צְבָא sava – means host or army.

<sup>11</sup>He even exalted himself as high as the Prince of the host; and by him the daily sacrifices were taken away, and the place of His sanctuary was cast down.

<sup>41</sup>The Son of Man will send out His angels, and they will gather out of His kingdom all things that offend, and those who practice lawlessness,

<sup>27</sup>For the Son of Man will come in the glory of His Father with His angels, and then He will reward each according to his works.

Then the sign of the Son of Man will appear in heaven, and then all the tribes of the earth will mourn, and they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.

<sup>31</sup>And He will send His angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they will gather together His elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.

<sup>16</sup>And He has on His robe and on His thigh a name written: KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS. King of Kings – Greek word - βασιλεύς basiloose – means Commander, Prince thus Prince of princes.

<sup>23</sup>Therefore Michal the daughter of Saul had no children to the day of her death.

You will keep in perfect and constant peace the one whose mind is steadfast [that is, committed and focused on You—in both inclination and character], Because he trusts and takes refuge in You [with hope and confident expectation]. Trust [confidently] in the LORD forever [He is your fortress, your shield, your banner], For the LORD GOD is an everlasting Rock [the Rock of
