¹⁸(They dwelt from Havilah **up to** Shur, which is east of Egypt as you go toward Assyria.) He died in the presence of all his brethren.


GENESIS 25:18

²³But Gideon said to them, "I will not rule over you, nor shall my son rule over you; the LORD shall rule over you."



²⁴who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the **tree**, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness—by whose stripes you were healed.
