JUDGES 8:22

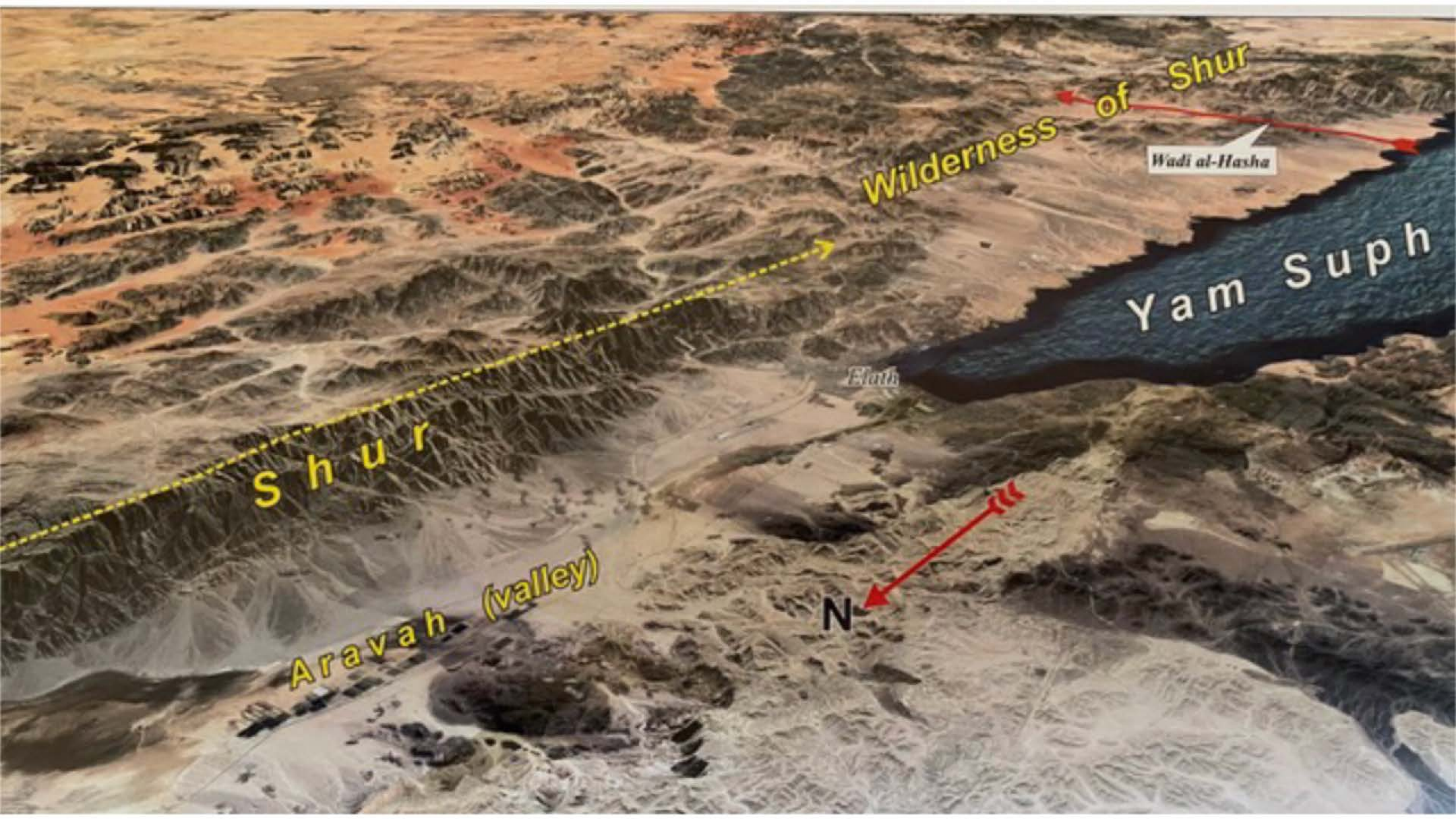
²³But Gideon said to them, “I will not rule over you, nor shall my son rule over you; the LORD shall rule over you.”

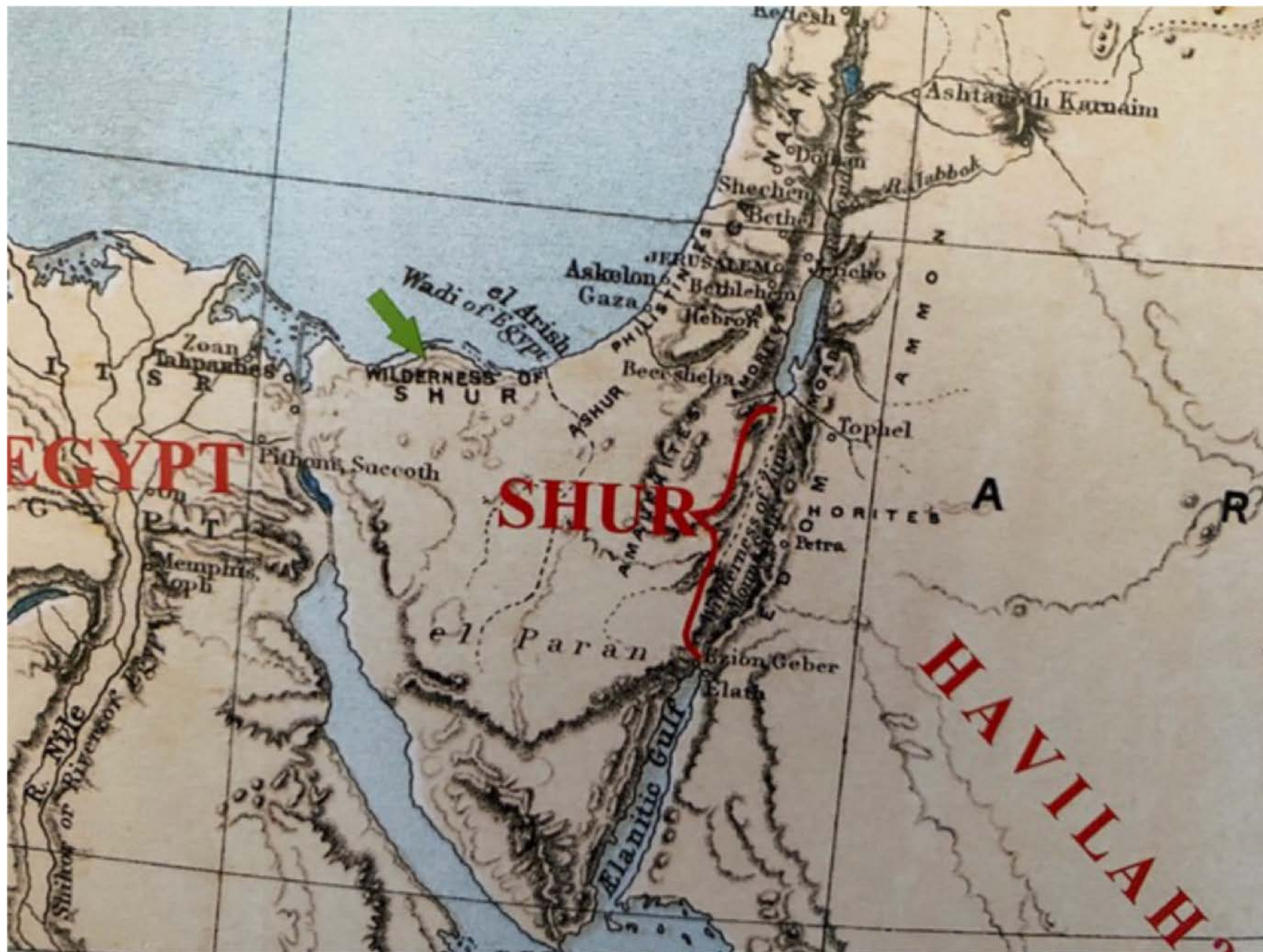
