Chief – Hebrew word – אֶלֹּף – al loof – means Duke. All the sons and grandsons of Esau that became Chiefs.

Amalek – Hebrew word – עֲמֶלֶק – ama
lake – means dweller in a valley.



¹⁷“Remember what Amalek did to you on the way as you were coming out of Egypt,
¹⁸how he met you on the way and attacked your rear ranks, all the stragglers at your rear, when you were tired and weary; and he did not fear God.

DEUTERONOMY 25:17-18

Joshua – Hebrew word – יהושוע – yeh-ho-shoo'-ah means YHWH is salvation.

¹³And Moses said to the people, “Do not be afraid. Stand still, and see the salvation of the LORD, which He will accomplish for you today. For the Egyptians whom you see today, you shall see again no more forever.

¹⁴The LORD will fight for you, and you shall hold your peace.”

Scoffing – Hebrew word – **צַחֵק** - tsaw-khak – means to laugh to mock, to make sport of. It is a play on words of Isaac's name.

Isaac – Hebrew word – **יִצְחָק** - yits-khawk' – means laughter

From G1453 ; to keep awake, be vigilant, to watch, to give strict attention to.
