Notice the qualifications:

Able men – Those who are willing, available and teachable.

Fear God – They must fear or be reverent toward God. They must respect God and be humble before God. They will also be worshippers of God. Men of prayer.

Men of Truth – These will be men of Integrity, they will do what is right and let God determine the outcome. Hating Covetousness – Men of Honor, they will not be materialistic. Riches will not be their motivation.

¹This is a faithful saying: If a man desires the position of a bishop, he desires a good work.

Bishop – Greek wd – ἐπισκοπή - ep is kopay means overseer, bishop. This is where we get the word Episcopalian.

F. Termination and Removal. For the purpose of the potential termination of the Senior Pastor/President/Chairman of the Board all requests and or accusations from any party concerning the removal of the Chairman of the Board/Senior Pastor shall require at least two (2) witnesses who must (a) substantiate the ground(s) for removal and (b) testify of facts, not hearsay, surrounding such accusations.

(1 Timothy 5:19-20) and, if there is incriminating evidence, then a 2/3 vote is required from the Board of Directors for removal. Grounds for termination and removal shall be related primarily to moral, financial or other spiritual integrity issues as outlined in 1Timothy 3:1-7 and Titus 1:5-9;16

The Board shall prayerfully and objectively weigh all accusations, issues, and testimonies concerning the charges against the Sr. Pastor. If, in the opinion of the Board, sufficient charges and evidence exist that lead them to recommend that the Sr. Pastor be removed, the Board will seek to bring in three (3) outside Calvary Chapel Sr. Pastors as an Advisory Board to assist them in their considerations and recommendation.

All of the charges, facts, evidence and conclusions will be presented to this Advisory Board who will then issue a recommendation to the Church Board of Directors. The Church Board will consider the Advisory Board's recommendation in developing its' final recommendation.
